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Scholastic 3D Archery

What is S3DA?

S3DA is a community-based next-step archery program designed to reach archers in grades 3-12. Archers are encouraged to shoot any type of equipment set-up ranging from Bowhunter to Barebow to Olympic-style recurve and more. S3DA has 3 main tournament formats: indoor target, outdoor 3D, and outdoor target.

What does an S3DA club do?

S3DA clubs provide a regular place for archers to come practice and continue learning about archery. During practice time, certified coaches work with archers to improve technique, build mental game, and keep archery fun and challenging. Clubs may hold league-like competitions amongst themselves, and archers are also encouraged to compete at the regional, state, and national levels. High school archers compete for scholarships nationally.

How can I start an S3DA club?

- ③ Contact ODFW's Archery Education Coordinator to schedule a 1-day, 8-hour training to obtain your certification (required for all coaches). **No cost.**
- ③ Get equipment! For a *limited time*, ODFW is assisting in providing equipment kits. *As of January 2017, details are still being determined. Thank you for your patience!*
