#### 2016 Forecasts

- ❖ LRH – Similar to 2015 actual return and greater than the 10-year average.
- ❖ LRW – Greater than the 10-year average.
- ❖ BPH – Slightly higher than the 10-year average.
- ❖ URB – Much higher than the 10-year average; would be the fourth highest return.
- ❖ BUB – Less than the 10-year average.
- ❖ PUB – Similar to the 10-year average.
- ❖ SAB – Greater than the 10-year average.
- ❖ Total Columbia River Forecast – Another strong return; much greater than 10-year average.
