



## Temporary Fisheries Employment Opportunities Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW)

- Classification:** Experimental Biology Aide – 2 Temporary Positions  
(Classification #C3769 – there is no job posting number for this recruitment)
- Salary Range:** \$2,200-\$2,281 per month (Commensurate with experience)
- Effective November 1, 2016, SEIU represented employees who are Public Employee Retirement System (PERS) participating members will have their base salary increased by 6.95%. Upon becoming a PERS participating member, SEIU employees pay the employee 6% contribution to PERS. - Location:** Tillamook
- Duration:** 2 months (August 15, 2017 – October 13, 2017)
- Job Description:** The employees in these positions will be conducting salmon spawning surveys. The primary responsibilities for these positions are to:
- Walk or float streams to count redds and spawning salmon.
  - Collect biological samples from dead fish.
  - Keep accurate and clear data records.
  - Hike into and along streams daily, requires some use of non-motorized inflatable boats.
  - Work in hot, cold, rainy weather, and in rough terrain.
  - Communicate with the public to gain access to private land and to explain our activities.
  - Coordinate with ODFW district staff.
  - Conduct surveys in non-motorized white water river craft in streams up to class III.
- These positions require a flexible work schedule that varies in the number of hours worked on a daily basis, but not necessarily each day, or a work schedule in which the starting and stopping times vary on a daily basis, but not necessarily each day. Positions may include work on weekends. These positions mainly conduct field work in and around streams, and can be physically demanding. Employees will occasionally be working independently under adverse weather conditions in semi-remote areas.
- Requirements:** Applicants must have a valid driver license and an acceptable driving record. ODFW will check driving records for in-state finalists. Out-of-state finalists will be required to present a current driving record for review.
- Minimum qualifications are not established for this position; however, previous experience with spawning surveys, salmonid identification and whitewater rafting/kayaking is preferred. Preference will also be given to applicants that have or are working toward a college degree with major emphasis in biological or ecological sciences.
