

Divide Ridge Access Area



The Divide Ridge Access Area is a cooperative program between private landowners and the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's Access and Habitat Program to maintain public hunting access on private lands and to increase access to public lands. The Divide Ridge Access Area 9 miles east of Joseph, OR provides public hunting opportunities for deer, elk, predators, valley quail, turkey and grouse. All Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife Regulations and Seasons Apply.

Access Allowed: In Effect Year Round

Hunting on Private Land is a privilege, not a right. Private land hunting opportunities will remain in the future only if the property and rights of private landowners are respected! Abuse it and you will lose it!

Area Regulations:

- Motorized vehicles only on open roads
- No littering, please pick up trash
- Report any unlawful activities
- Respect landowner rights and needs
- Leave all gates as you found them
