Cooperative Travel Management Area

Wallowa-Whitman National Forest
Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife

Within the following Travel Management Area boundaries, motorized vehicle travel on roads (except where indicated open), trails and cross-country is not allowed during periods of restrictions except by special permit from the Wallowa-Whitman National Forest.

The Wallowa-Whitman National Forest intends to implement a new travel management plan in the near future. Please check with a Wallowa-Whitman National Forest Ranger District for more information about motorized travel.

Area	Period of Restriction
Mehlhorn	Yearlong
Eagle Creek	Dec. 1 through Apr. 15, 2017
Summit Point	Yearlong

In the following areas only those roads shown in green, and the adjacent area within 300 feet of those roads, are open to motorized vehicles during the period of restrictions. Motorized vehicle travel within the Travel Management Area boundary on all other roads and trails, and cross-country is prohibited except by special permit from the Wallowa-Whitman National Forest. Mehlhorn and Summit Point are open to over-snow vehicles operating on 12" or more of snow from Dec. 1 to June 30.

Area	Period of Restriction
Lake Fork-Dutchman	Aug. 27 through Nov. 27; May 1 through July 1, 2017
Okanogan-Fish	Sep. 28 through Nov. 27; May 1 through July 1, 2017

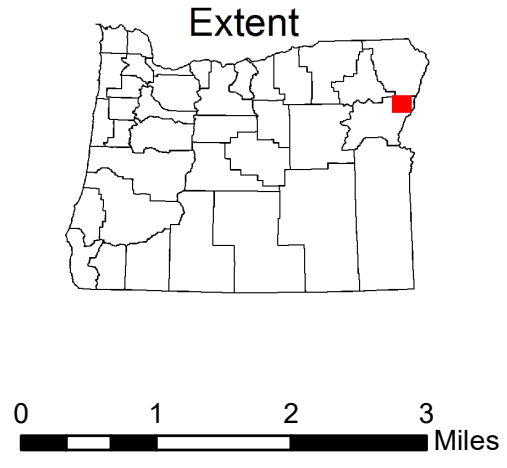
