The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife welcomes wildlife oriented educational and recreational use of properties it administers and asks your cooperation in maintaining the lands in an attractive and productive condition.

The White River Wildlife Area was initiated in 1953. The primary objective is to provide Blacktailed deer and Rocky Mountain elk winter ranges and reduce crop damage to adjacent private lands.

A total of 30,000 acres have been acquired by fee title and agreement. Private and U.S.F.S. lands are intermingled with state lands. You are welcome to use the state-controlled properties for authorized activities, but you must secure the permission of private land owners before hunting or recreating on those private lands.

On wildlife area lands, roads open year-round to vehicular travel are shown in green. Seasonal roads open April 1 to November 30 use the green dot roa
