2011 Trout Stocking Sites

- *REVISED January 2011* -

North Coast Watershed District Clatsop, Columbia, Lane, Tillamook Counties

ALDER LAKE - A 3-acre trout lake in Siuslaw National Forest, 7.6 miles north of Florence. West of Hwy 101, about 1/2 mile north of Sutton Lake.

BATTLE LAKE - A 2-acre easy hike-in lake in the Siuslaw National Forest. From Tillamook head south on Hwy 101 approximately 11.5 miles to Hemlock. Turn east on East Beaver Creek Rd next to Bear Creek Artichokes. Stay on East Beaver Creek Rd for approximately 3 miles to where the pavement ends past the last farm house. Turn right on Forest Service Rd 8172 and go about 2 miles to a spur road on the right. Battle Lake is approximately 1.25 miles down the spur road on the left side.

BIG CREEK RESERVOIR #1 & #2 - Two 20-acre reservoirs on the north edge of Newport offering year-round fishing for stocked trout, with some opportunity for bass and bullheads. The reservoirs are just north of Yaquina Bay, accessible from Hwy 101 by way of Big Creek Rd just north of Hotel Newport and south of Agate Beach.

BUCK LAKE - a 5-acre lake about 4.5 miles north of Florence, 1/4 mile south of Alder and Dune lakes. A trail on the west side of the highway leads a few hundred feet to the lake.

CAPE MEARES LAKE -Tillamook County's largest lake, from Tillamook, head west on Third Street, then right onto Bay Ocean Rd to the lake.

CARTER LAKE - Lake is one mile long and 400 ft wide. It is reached by Hwy 101 about 9 miles south of Florence. The lake is on the west side of the Hwy

CLEAWOX LAKE - Lake is located within Honeyman State Park a few miles south of Florence.

COFFENBURY LAKE - A-accessible fishing- Located in Fort Stevens State Park at Hammond. From Astoria take Hwy 101 south, turn towards Warrenton, follow signs to Hammond, turn left at 4-ay stop, park entrance will be on the right side of the road. From Seaside take Hwy 101 north to Lake Drive, sign will direct you to Fort Stevens State Park.

CULLABY LAKE – A 220-acre lake located east of Hwy 101, four miles north of Gearhart. The site has two boat launches and docks for easy fishing access. Trout are stocked and warmwater fish are present.



DEVILS LAKE - Take Hwy 18 through McMinnville to Hwy 101 a few miles south of Lincoln City.

DUNE LAKE - A Lake in the Siuslaw National Forest, 7.6 miles north of Florence. West of Hwy 101, about 1/2 mile north of Sutton Lake.

ECKMAN LAKE - A 45-acre lake adjacent to the lower Alsea River off Hwy 34, about 2 miles east of Waldport.

ELBOW LAKE - A 13-acre lake, south of Tahkenitch Lake, on the west side of Hwy 101.

ERHART LAKE - A small lake on the west side of Hwy 101, about 8 miles south of Florence near Siltcoos Lake.

GEORGIA LAKE - - 6 miles south of Florence off of Hwy 101 opposite the Siltcoos Lake outlet and campground. Access is from the east side of the highway.

HEBO LAKE - A 2-acre lake 3.5 miles east of the Hebo Ranger Station on The Hebo Mt. Rd. From Hebo, take Hwy 22 1/4 miles east then turn left onto Forest Rd 14.

LAKE LYTLE - A 65-acre lake located one-half mile north of Rockaway Beach on Hwy 101. The lake sits directly along the highway's east edge. There is a public angling dock located directly off Hwy 101 with parking on the highway shoulder. Several other bank access locations are present along the shoulder also. There is a boat launch off of 12th Street on the north end of the lake.

LOREN'S POND - Located 3/10 mile west of Trask Hatchery. From Long Prairie Rd turn east on Chance Rd towards Trask Hatchery. Turn left onto gravel road approximately 2.2 miles from intersection look for a small white triangular angler access sign. Follow the gravel road past a barn and farm house, at this point the road curves to the left proceed approximately 200 yards. The pond is in an old gravel pit on the left at the wide turnout.

LOST LAKE - Turn south off Hwy 26 (Sunset Hwy) approximately 1/2 mile east of Olney's Restaurant onto Lower Nehalem River Rd. Travel approximately 8 miles to Spruce Run Park. Just before entering the park there is a logging road (Lost Lake Rd) heading east. Follow Lost Lake Rd for approximately 5 miles to the lake.

LOST LAKE - A 6-acre lake east of Hwy 101 mid-way between Tahkenitch and Siltcoos lakes.

MERCER LAKE - Located east of Hwy 101, about 5 miles north of Florence. A county road leads from the highway around the south shore. The north shore road deadens at the head of the valley, offering no access to the lake.

MUNSEL LAKE Located 1.5 miles north of Florence east of Hwy 101 on Munsel Lake Rd.

NEDONNA POND - A small pond located just north of Rockaway. From Hwy 101 on the north end of Rockaway (near Neahkanie High School), turn west toward Manhattan Beach. The pond is a short distance off Hwy 101, on the right just after crossing the railroad tracks.

NORTH LAKE: A small lake located about 1 mile north of South Lake. Follow directions to South Lake. The lake will be on your left as you are coming down from Mt. Hebo. Trout stocking is very limited here, and shoreline access is somewhat difficult.

NORTH GEORGIA LAKE - 6 miles south of Florence off of Hwy 101 opposite the Siltcoos Lake outlet and campground. Access is from the east side of the Hwy

OLALLA CREEK RESERVOIR – A 120-acre reservoir on the Olalla Creek. From Toledo, follow Hwy 20 east about a mile, then turn left (north) on Olalla Rd, which reaches the reservoir in less than 3 miles.

PERKINS LAKE - A 5-acre lake in the Oregon Dunes National Recreation Area about 10 miles south of Florence. The lake is just west of Hwy 101 and a few miles north of Tahkenitch Lake.

SILTCOOS LAKE - Located 6 miles south of Florence off of Hwy 101. To reach the East shore, follow Canary Rd east and south from Honeyman State Park a very winding 15 miles.

SMITH LAKE - A 35-acre lake located 2 miles north of Garibaldi on Hwy 101. Private land surrounds most of this lake. Bank access is limited from the highway side and requires a short walk over uneven terrain. Stocking is done at the dock located at Camp Magruder.

SOUTH LAKE - A 5-acre trout lake south of Hebo Lake, in Hebo turn south off of Hwy 101 onto Hwy 22, head south for 1/4 mile turn left onto forest service road at the Siuslaw National Forest sign. It is 13 miles from that point to the lake. There is a "T" intersection 6.5 miles from Hwy 22 turn left, from the "T" go 1 & 4/10 miles to a 4 way intersection, turn left. From the 4 way intersection go 4 & 2/10 miles to a "Y" turn left this is forest service road 1428RD Take the first right after the "Y", this leads to the lake.

SPRING LAKE - A 13-acre lake located on the east side of Hwy 101 4 miles north of Garibaldi. Public access is limited to the Hwy shoulder. There is no public ramp; stocking is done at the resort located at the north end of the lake.

SUNSET LAKE (Clatsop County) - Turn west off of Hwy 101 onto Sunset Beach Rd (by the Astoria Golf and Country Club). Lake is located approximately 1/2 mile off of Hwy 101, and has a ramp on the north side of the bridge. Sunset Beach Rd is located approximately 7 miles north of Seaside.

SUTTON LAKE - Located 6 miles north of Florence.

TAHOE LAKE - From Tillamook go east on 3rd Street for 2 miles, turn right onto Trask River Rd Follow Trask River Rd for 1.5 miles. At this point Trask River Rd turns left, follow Trask River Rd for approximately 11 miles. You will cross a bridge and the pavement ends. Stay on the main gravel road. It is 6.5 miles from the bridge to Tahoe Lake. A spur road off to the right is signed "Tahoe Lake." The lake is at the end of the spur road. Please note that the forest roads are single lane and rough

THISSEL POND - A 3-acre fish pond located about 15 miles west of Alsea, turn north on Forest Rd 62 toward Fall Creek Hatchery. Thissel pond is about a mile down stream from the Hatchery.

TOWN LAKE - A 9-acre lake near the community of Woods. From Hebo, travel south on Hwy 101 to the Pacific City-Woods junction, and turn right towards Woods (Old Woods Rd). Continue 3 miles to the community of Woods, turn right at the bridge, and continue one mile on the main road. The lake is on the right. Parking is limited.

VERNONIA POND - Located at the north end of Vernonia on Hwy 47 approximately 2/10 mile past the Vernonia Fire Dept. The pond is on the east side of Hwy 47.

WOAHINK LAKE - 350 acre Lake located 3 miles south of Florence its shoreline forms the eastern boundary of Honeyman State Park.
