George Lockwood developed a passion for wildlife and the outdoors while camping, hunting and fishing in the western United States and Mexico as a boy. He began painting professionally while living and working in Alaska, specializing in wildlife and landscape. Later, he moved to Arizona to broaden his range of subject matter and devote his full attention to art. His artwork has won stamp contests and awards from coast to coast, including 2 consecutive Oregon upland game bird stamps. Mr. Lockwood's artwork is inspired by first-hand knowledge of his subject, as clearly evidenced by his painting of mountain quail. The artist resides on California's central coast.
