# Oregon Ocean Commercial Trawl Salmon Alternative 1 – 3/9/26



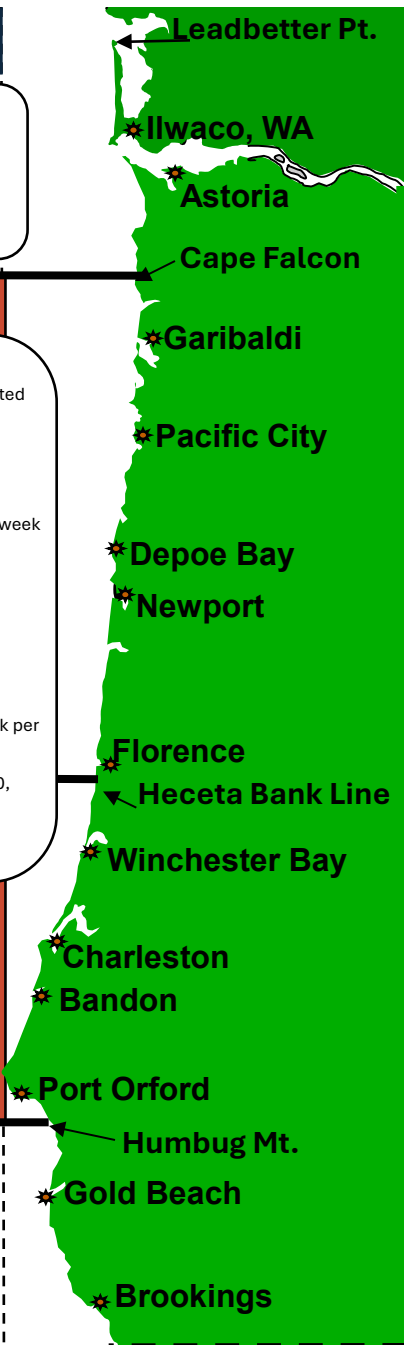
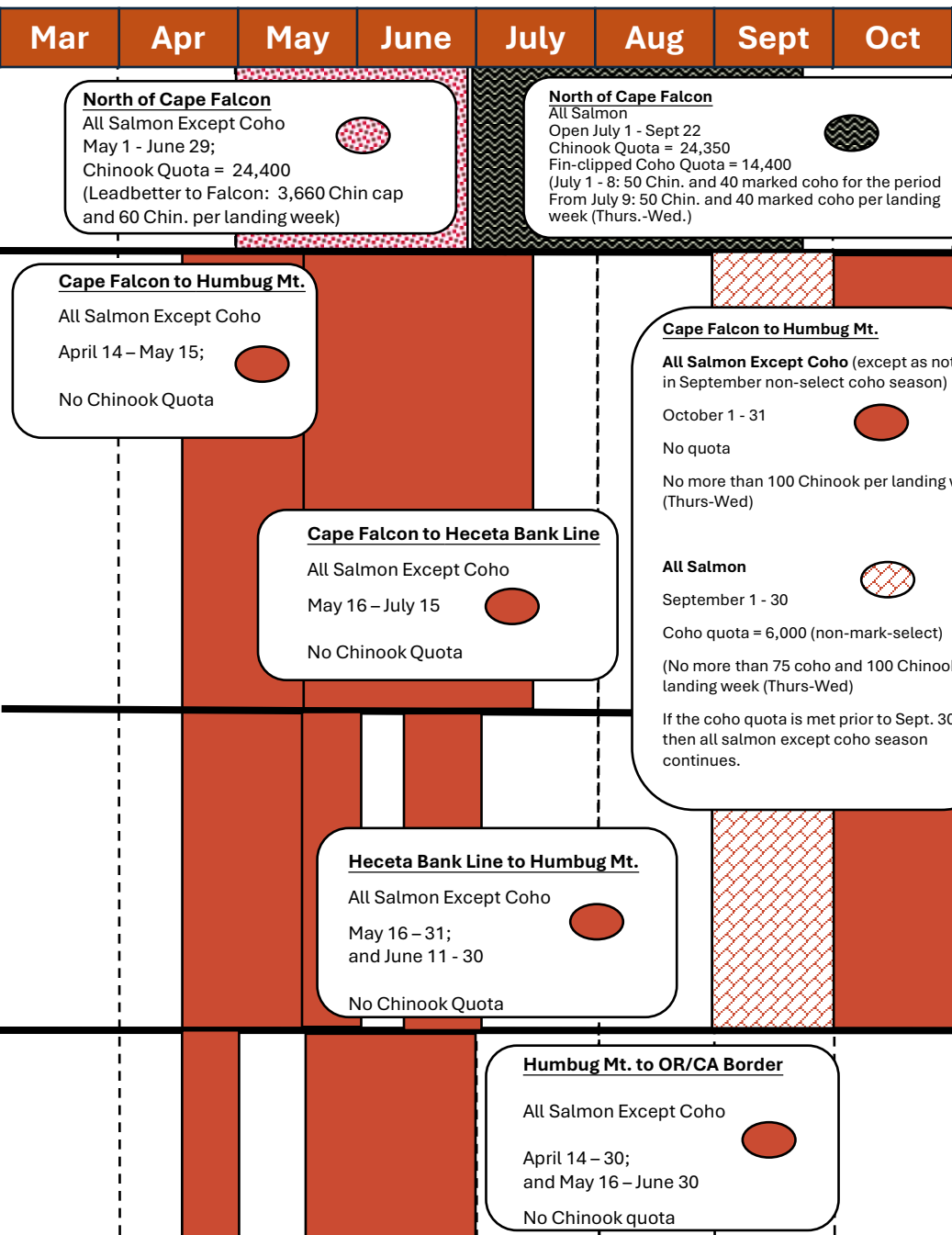
- All salmon except coho. Vessels fishing south of Leadbetter Pt., WA must land their catch south of Leadbetter Pt. Vessels fishing north of Leadbetter Pt., must land their catch north of Leadbetter Pt. Landings restricted to within the open area and Garibaldi only. Must land all catch within 24 hours of any closure. Chinook 27" minimum length. All landings into Oregon must be reported within one hour of landing at (541) 857-2546 or to [nfalcon.trollreport@odfw.Oregon.gov](mailto:nfalcon.trollreport@odfw.Oregon.gov) Landing week defined as Thursday-Wednesday.
- All salmon, all coho must have a healed adipose fin clip. Vessels landing south of Leadbetter Pt., WA may only fish south of Leadbetter Pt. Vessels fishing north of Leadbetter Pt., must land their catch north of Leadbetter Pt. Landings restricted to within the open area and Garibaldi only. Must land all catch within 24 hours of any closure. Chinook 27" and coho 16" minimum length.
