### Ocean Recreational Season between Leadbetter Pt., WA and Cape Falcon, OR

Seasons: Open June 19-26 for all salmon except coho, one salmon per day. Open June 27 through the earlier of September 15 or 42,400 marked Coho quota (Chinook guideline of 7,200). Two salmon per day, but no more than one Chinook, and all Coho must have a healed adipose fin clip.
