## Preliminary 2024 Oregon Ocean Recreational Salmon Estimates:



### Ocean Recreational Season between Leadbetter Pt., WA and Cape Falcon, OR

Season: Open June 22 through earlier of September 30 or quota. Bag limit of two salmon per day, but no more than one Chinook, and all Coho must have a healed adipose fin clip. Min. lengths: Coho 16", Chinook 22", and steelhead 20". Coho quota: 39,900; Chinook guideline: 12,510. Columbia River Control Zone closed to salmon angling from a boat.
