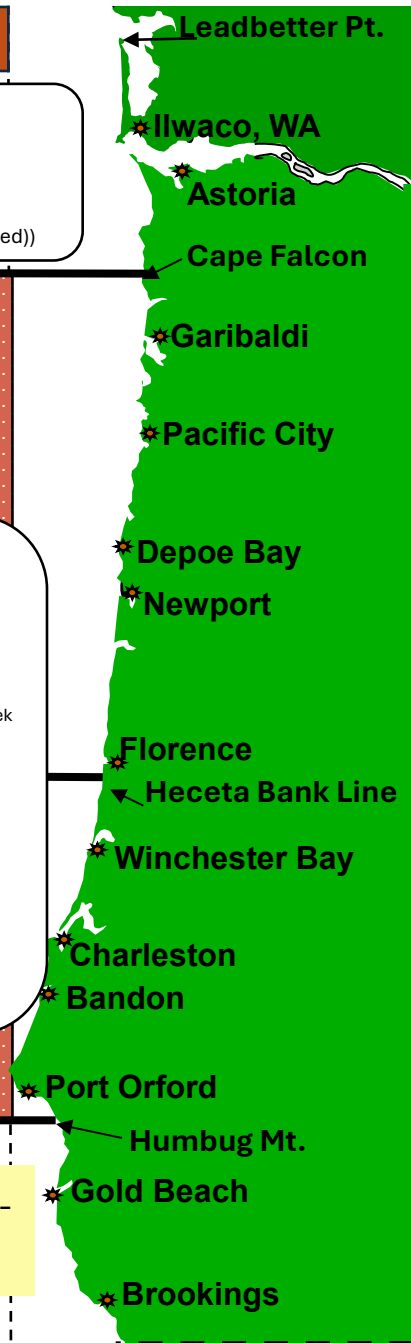


Oregon Ocean Commercial Troll Salmon – 2026

North of Cape Falcon

All Salmon Except Coho
 May 1 - June 29;
 Chinook Quota = 37,300
 Leadbetter to Falcon: 5,590 Chin cap. **May 1-13, 80**
Chin. per vessel per landing week (Th-W) May 16-20;
 50 Chin. per vessel for the period; and beginning May
14 21, 50 80 Chin. per landing week (Th-W)



North of Cape Falcon

All Salmon
 Open July 1 - Sept 30
 Chinook Quota = 18,700
 Fin-clipped Coho Quota = 19,600
 (50 marked coho per landing week (Thurs-Wed))



Cape Falcon to Heceta Bank Line

All Salmon Except Coho
 July 16 – July 31*
 No Chinook Quota



Cape Falcon to Humbug Mt.

All Salmon Except Coho
 April 14 – June 30;
 No Chinook Quota



Cape Falcon to Humbug Mt.

All Salmon Except Coho (except as noted
 in September non-select coho season)

September 1 – October 31
 No more than 100 Chinook per landing week
 (Thurs-Wed)



All Salmon

September 1 - 30
 Coho quota = 7,000 (non-mark-select)
 No more than 100 coho and 100 Chinook
 per landing week (Thurs-Wed)
 If the coho quota is met prior to Sept. 30,
 then all salmon except coho season
 continues



Humbug Mt. to OR/CA Border

All Salmon Except Coho
 April 14 - 30
 May 16 – June 17
 No Chinook Quota

All salmon except coho. Vessels fishing south of Leadbetter Pt., WA must land their catch south of Leadbetter Pt. Vessels fishing north of Leadbetter Pt., must land their catch north of Leadbetter Pt. Landings restricted to within the open area and Garibaldi only. Must land all catch within 24 hours of any closure. Chinook 27" minimum length. All landings into Oregon **must be reported at least one hour prior to landing** at (541) 857-2546 or to OR.trollreport@odfw.Oregon.gov. Landing week defined as Thursday-Wednesday.



All salmon, all coho must have a healed adipose fin clip. Vessels landing south of Leadbetter Pt., WA may only fish south of Leadbetter Pt. Vessels fishing north of Leadbetter Pt., must land their catch north of Leadbetter Pt. Landings restricted to within the open area and Garibaldi only. Must land all catch within 24 hours of any closure. Chinook 27" and coho 16" minimum length. All landings into Oregon **must be reported at least one hour prior to landing** at (541) 857-2546 or to OR.trollreport@odfw.Oregon.gov. Landing week defined as Thursday-Wednesday.



All salmon except coho. All fish must be landed into Oregon. ***In July, all vessels landing salmon south of the Heceta Bank Line are required to notify ODFW prior to crossing the Heceta Bank Line** at (541) 857-2546 or to OR.trollreport@odfw.Oregon.gov. No more than 4 spreads per wire. Chinook 28" minimum length.



All salmon. All fish must be landed into Oregon. No restrictions on the number of spreads. Chinook 28" and coho 16" minimum length. All coho landings **must be reported at least one hour prior to landing** at (541) 857-2546 or to OR.trollreport@odfw.Oregon.gov. No more than 100 coho and 100 Chinook per landing week. Landing week defined as Thursday-Wednesday.



All salmon except coho. All fish must be landed into Oregon. No restrictions on the number of spreads. Chinook 28" minimum length. No more than 100 Chinook per vessel per landing week (Thursday-Wednesday)

Incidental Troll Halibut: 1 Pacific Halibut per each 2 Chinook landed up to 35 halibut per trip (1 halibut may be landed without meeting the ratio). Minimum size of 32 inches
