- The meeting will be held in the Gladys Valley Marine Studies auditorium on the Hatfield Marine Science Center campus in Newport. We will open the auditorium at 9:30 AM, with the meeting starting at 10:00 AM.
- The meeting will be recorded. Please keep comments respectful of all attendees and “G” rated. The recording of the meeting will be posted to the ODFW Ocean Salmon website (<https://dfw.state.or.us/mrp/salmon/>) by the end of the week.
