Area 2 - Columbia River Area – Includes effort and catch from Leadbetter Point, WA to Cape Falcon

Area 3 - Tillamook Area – Includes effort and catch from Cape Falcon to Cascade Head

Area 4 - Newport Area – Includes effort and catch from Cascade Head to S. end of Heceta Bank

Area 5 - Coos Bay Area – Includes effort and catch from S. end of Heceta Bank to Humbug Mountain

Area 6 - Brookings Area – Includes effort and catch from Humbug Mountain to Point St. George, CA

Note: Landings from California into Oregon are not permitted under current ocean salmon regulations. Thus, this area effectively is from Humbug Mt. to the Oregon/California Border.
