- <u>Area 5</u> <u>Coos Bay Area</u> Includes effort and catch from Heceta Head to Humbug Mountain
- <u>Area 6</u> <u>Brookings Area</u> Includes effort and catch from Humbug Mountain to Point St. George, CA
 Note: Landings from California into Oregon are not permitted under current ocean salmon regulations. Thus, this area effectively is from Humbug Mt. to the Oregon/California Border.
