NEED FOR THE RULE(S):

This rule is needed to authorize sales of white sturgeon caught during the Treaty setline fishery in Bonneville Pool from February 12-16, 2026, in The Dalles Pool from February 18-21, 2026, and in John Day Pool from February 18-21, 2026. In-season monitoring by the tribes indicates these fisheries are within allowable harvest levels.

JUSTIFICATION OF TEMPORARY FILING:

There is not adequate time to go through normal rulemaking proceedings to modify these tribal fisheries by the specified date and time.

Failure to adopt these rules would deny tribal fishers the opportunity to sell their harvested fish in Oregon, which would cause economic hardship. This temporary rule will avoid these consequences by allowing the sale of fish caught in this fishery to Oregon-licensed buyers.

RULE SUMMARY: This amended rule provides state authorization of sales of white sturgeon caught in the winter

Treaty setline fisheries in Bonneville Pool, The Dalles Pool, and John Day Pool to reflect recent tribal action to adopt these fisheries.

CHANGES TO RULE:

635-041-0063

Sturgeon Setline Fishery ¶

(1) White sturgeon may be taken by setline for commercial purposes ~~from 12 Noon January 1 through 12 Noon January 31 in all of Zone 6.~~¶

~~(a) In The Dalles and John Day pools was follows:~~¶

(a) In The Dalles and John Day pools from 6:00 AM February 18, 2026 through 6:00 PM February 21, 2026. White sturgeon taken must be 43-54 inches in fork length.¶

(b) In the Bonneville Pool wfrom 6:00 AM February 12, 2026 through 6:00 PM February 16, 2026. White sturgeon taken must be 38-54 inches in fork length.¶

(c) White sturgeon taken as described in subsections (1)(a) and (1)(b) of this rule may be sold or kept for subsistence use.¶

(2) Closed areas are set forth under OAR 635-041-0045.¶

(3) During the white sturgeon setline season it shall be unlawful to:¶

(a) Operate any fishing gear other than setlines except as provided in OAR 635-041-0060;¶

(b) Operate any setline having more than 100 hooks;¶

(c) Use other than single hooks size 9/0 or larger;¶

(4) The owner's tribal affiliation and enrollment number must be placed on the anchored ends of setlines and to the anchor floats to which the setlines are attached.¶

(5) Notwithstanding OAR 635-041-0045(6)-(11), it is lawful during the open season to fish for white sturgeon by means of set lines in the Columbia River within areas at and adjacent to the mouths of rivers.
