\* The directed sardine fishery was subject to coastwide closures that affected the start and/or end dates and the number of days the fishery was open in Oregon. In 2008 the 1<sup>st</sup> Period Allocation closed on May 29, preventing the fishery from starting in June, the 2<sup>nd</sup> period closed early preventing fishing from August 9 to September 15, and 3<sup>rd</sup> period closed September 22. In 2009 the 1<sup>st</sup> Period closed February 20 preventing fishing until July 1.
