BAIT HARVEST LOGBOOK INSTRUCTIONS

Reference numbers are on the example page.

1. Print the year the fish are landed (Example: 2009).
2. Vessel Name – Print the name of boat.
3. Vessel Doc. No. – Print the Federal, US Coast Guard, documentation number or state assigned (OR, WA, CA, etc.) number.
4. Estuary – Print the estuary name where the bait fish were harvested.
5. Home Port – Print the name of the home port of the vessel.
6. Gear – Circle the gear used (hook and line, net, or other). If other is circled, explain on the comment line.
7. Type of Net – If nets are fished, circle the type of net (purse seine, lampara, or other). If other is circled, explain on the comment line.
8. Length of Net – If net is fished, print the average length in feet of net gear fished (Example: 300ft).
9. Date – Print the month and day the bait was harvested.
10. Time (24 hour clock) – Print the time of day the gear was set (Set) and retrieved (Up) for each set of gear.
Use 24-hour clock (8:00am = 0800 and 1:00pm = 1300).
11. Number of Hauls – Print the number of times the net was set and hauled.
12. Number of Scoops – Print the number of scoops taken.
13. Average Size of Scoop – Print the average size of scoop taken in pounds.
14. Size Range – Print the size range of usable anchovies taken.
15. Depth – Print the bottom depth (in feet) where the gear is set.
16. Location in Estuary – Print a description of the location of the estuary fished.
17. Estimated Weight of Anchovies – Print your estimate in pounds of anchovies harvested.
18. Estimated Number of (*Blank Space*) **RELEASED** – Print the species name and the estimate (in number of fish) of the species released/discarded (include all fish released/discarded, including but not limited to prohibited species and fish discarded because of condition). If more space is needed record the information on the next page making sure to identify the day.
19. Captain's Signature – All captains must sign all logbook pages to show that information provided in the logbook is complete, accurate, and truthful.
20. Comments – This space is provided for things of interest to the captain, such as weather, sea conditions, fish behavior, markets, etc.
