Option #1 Existing Rules Relating to Mandatory Hunter Orange

The wearing of hunter orange while hunting in Oregon is voluntary. There are no existing OARs to reference.

Draft Rules for Implementing Mandatory Hunter Orange Option #2

635-065-0012

No person younger than 18 years of age shall hunt with any firearm any game mammal or upland game bird (excluding turkey) unless the person is wearing in a manner visible from all directions a hat and exterior garment of fluorescent orange. "Exterior garment" means a shirt, jacket, coat, vest or sweater. Fluorescent orange camouflage patterns are acceptable. "Hat" means any head covering. Not subject to this rule are:

- (a) Department employees and agents and the Oregon State Police while acting in their official capacities.**
- (b) Persons taking wildlife for damage under authority of ORS 498.012.**
- (c) Persons taking a wolf or wolves under authority of OAR chapter 635, division 110.**
- (d) Persons taking helpless or crippled wildlife under authority of ORS 498.016.**

Draft Rules for Implementing Mandatory Hunter Orange Option #3

635-065-0012

No person shall hunt with a centerfire firearm or shotgun any game mammal or upland game bird (excluding turkey) unless the person is wearing in a manner visible from all directions an exterior garment of fluorescent orange. "Exterior garment" means a hat, shirt, jacket, coat, vest or sweater. Fluorescent orange camouflage patterns are acceptable. "Hat" means any head covering. Not subject to this rule are:

- (a) Department employees and agents and the Oregon State Police while acting in their official capacities.**
- (b) Persons taking wildlife for damage under authority of ORS 498.012.**
- (c) Persons taking a wolf or wolves under authority of OAR chapter 635, division 110.**
- (d) Persons taking helpless or crippled wildlife under authority of ORS 498.016.**
