2 **Inclusions and Modifications**

3 (1) The **2012 Oregon Sport Fishing Regulations** provide requirements for the Willamette Zone. However,
4 additional regulations may be adopted in this rule division from time to time and to the extent of any
5 inconsistency, they supersede the **2012 Oregon Sport Fishing Regulations**.

6 (2) Pacific Lamprey Harvest:

7 (a) Pursuant to OAR 635-044-0130(1)(b), authorization from the Oregon Fish and Wildlife Commission must
8 be in possession by individuals collecting or possessing Pacific lamprey for personal use. Permits are available
9 from ODFW, 17330 SE Evelyn Street, Clackamas, OR 97015;

10 (b) Open fishing period is June 1 through July 31 from 7:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M.; personal use harvest is
11 permitted Friday through Monday each week. All harvest is prohibited Tuesday through Thursday;

12 (c) Open fishing area is the Willamette River at Willamette Falls on the east side of the falls only, excluding
13 Horseshoe Area at the peak of the falls;

14 (d) Gear is restricted to hand or hand-powered tools only;

15 (e) Catch must be recorded daily on a harvest record card prior to leaving the open fishing area. Harvest
16 record cards will be provided by ODFW. All harvest record cards must be returned to the ODFW Clackamas
17 office by August 31 to report catch. Permit holders who do not return the harvest record cards by August 31 will
18 be ineligible to receive a permit in the following year.

19 (f) Harvesters must allow sampling or enumeration of catches by ODFW personnel.

20 **(3) Sandy River (Multnomah/Clackamas Co.) Mainstem and tributaries upstream from ODFW markers at**
21 **the mouth of the Salmon River, including the Salmon River:**

22 **(a) Open for adipose fin-clipped steelhead and non-adipose fin-clipped steelhead harvest July 1-**
23 **August 31.**

24 **(b) Angling restricted to artificial flies and lures with a single point hook no larger than 1/2 inch gap**
25 **(size 1) and multiple point hook no larger than 3/8 inch gap (size 4).**

26 **(c) No limit on size or number of brook trout taken. Catch limits on other trout species do not apply to**
27 **brook trout.**

8 **angling may be adopted after the printing of the 2012 Oregon Sport Fishing Regulations. Up-to-date**

11 **(b) Open for adipose fin-clipped coho salmon and adipose fin-clipped steelhead entire year, from**
12 **mouth to mainstem confluence with the East Fork and the West Fork from the confluence with the**
13 **mainstem upstream to the angling deadline 200 feet downstream of Punchbowl Falls.**

14 **(c) Catch and release only for trout, May 26-Oct. 31.**

15 **(d) Restricted to artificial flies and lures when angling for trout in all tributaries and in mainstem Hood**
16 **River upstream from the confluence with the West Fork.**

17 **(e) Use of bait allowed for salmon and steelhead.**

18 **(f) All other catch limits and restrictions remain unchanged from those listed for Hood River in the**
19 **2012 Oregon Sport Fishing Regulations.**
