Now that I have been through all 3 documents, a few general comments - it seems to me you could further streamline / simplify by gathering the general definitions in one Division (6 is most logical) and not repeating them in all 3 Divisions. There are several instances of boilerplate language - application requirements, repeal of permit denial, transferability of permits - which are common across all fisheries; seems like these too could go into Division 6 (or someplace else?) as general regulations. That may be a task that will take even more time and effort than you have allotted but it's worth considering.
