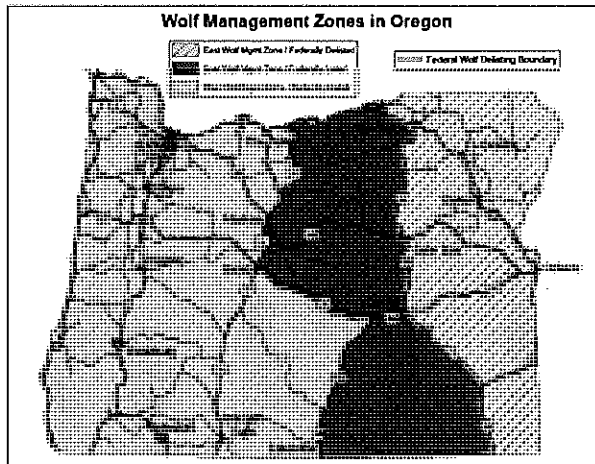






2015: Phase II of Wolf Plan

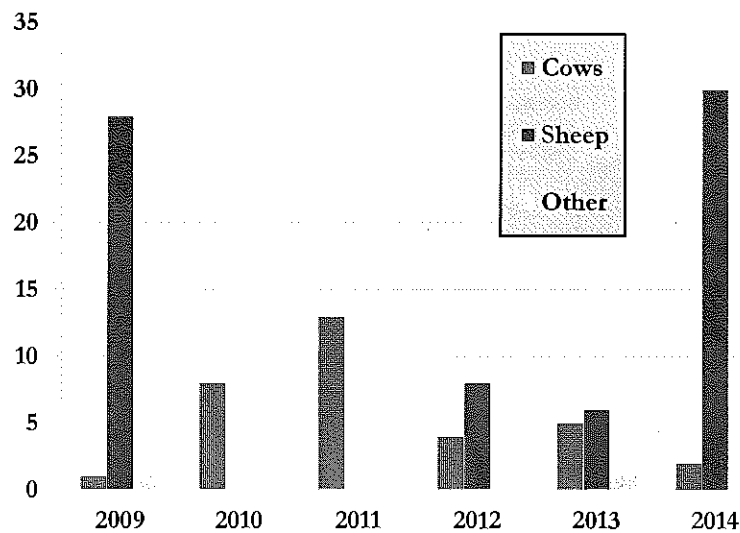
- Phase I remains in western zone (light blue)
- Phase II rule in eastern zone only



Phase II increases flexibilities for producers to protect livestock

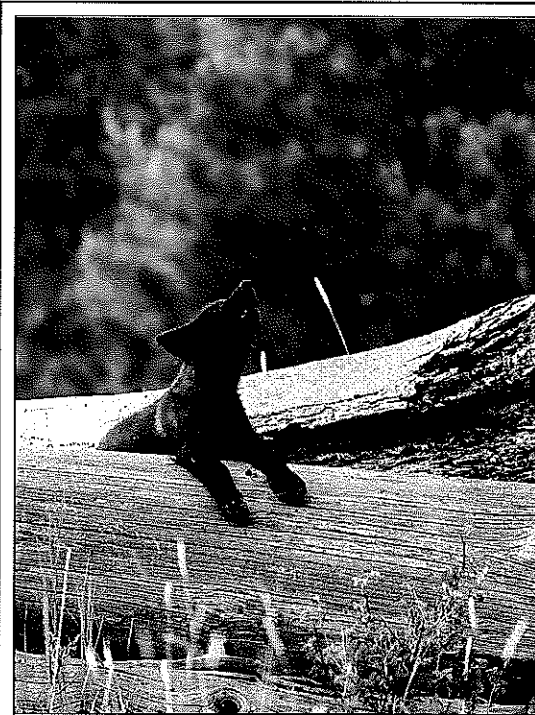
- Lethal take of wolves attacking or chasing livestock under specific circumstances
- “Chronic” depredation defined as 2 confirmed depredations
- Less administrative rule/procedure
- Non-lethal measures still required before lethal control is considered by agency.

Wolf-Caused Livestock Losses



Capture and Monitoring

- 18 Wolves (collared) monitored
- 3 Collared wolves dispersed out of state
- 6 New wolves collared in 2014
