2 **Purpose and Scope**

3 (1) The purpose of Division 003 is to provide for management of commercial salmon fisheries off the
4 Oregon Coast over which the state has jurisdiction.

5 (2) Division 003 incorporates into Oregon Administrative Rules, by reference, the annual ocean troll
6 salmon specifications and management measures as adopted by the **Pacific Fishery Management**
7 **Council** in its annual **Ocean Salmon Management Measures and Impacts**, as finalized in April
8 2015[2014], and in addition to the extent they are consistent with these rules, **Code of Federal**
9 **Regulations (CFR), Title 50, Part 660, Subpart H (61FR34572, July 2, 1996**, as amended to
10 incorporate the standards in the **Pacific Fishery Management Council referenced document**).

11 Therefore, persons must consult the **Pacific Fishery Management Council referenced document** and
12 **Federal Regulations** in addition to Division 003 to determine all applicable troll salmon fishing
13 requirements. A copy of the **Pacific Fishery Management Council referenced document** and the
14 **Federal Regulations** may be obtained by contacting the **Pacific Fishery Management Council** at

16 (3) To the extent not preempted by Federal law, these regulations apply within the State of Oregon's
17 Fisheries Conservation Zone (out to fifty miles from shore).

22 **Fish Receiving Ticket - Salmon**

23 (1) This regulation is in addition to, and not in lieu of the provisions contained in OAR 635-006-0210.

24 (2) Fish receiving tickets shall be completed at time of landing and the original copy forwarded within
25 four consecutive days following the landing to the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

26 (3) For troll-caught salmon, fish receiving tickets shall show the number **of each species of salmon**
27 **landed, the number of halibut landed, if any, and the number** of days fished during the trip in which
28 the salmon were caught.

33 **Fish Receiving Ticket - Limited Fish Seller Permit**

34 (1) This regulation is in addition to, and not in lieu of the provisions contained in OAR 635-006-0210.

35 (2) For food fish or shellfish sold under a Limited Fish Seller Permit, the Limited Fish Seller shall
36 complete daily entries of fish sold on a Fish Receiving Ticket. Fish Receiving Tickets are prenumbered
37 in books of 50 tickets. Limited Fish Sellers shall account for all Fish Receiving Tickets received from
38 the Department. Fish Receiving Tickets shall be issued in numerical sequence. The Fish Receiving
39 Ticket shall include, for each day's sales:

40 (a) Limited Fish Seller's name and license number;

41 (b) Date of sales;

42 (c) Boat name and federal document or State Marine Board number from which catch made;

43 (d) For groundfish harvested in the limited entry fixed gear fishery, the federal limited entry fixed
44 gear permit number associated with the landing or portion of landing;

45 (e) Port of first landing. The port of first landing will be recorded as where a vessel initially crosses
46 from the Pacific Ocean to inland waters, or is physically removed from the Pacific Ocean, for the
47 purposes of ending a fishing trip;

48 (f) Fishing gear used;

49 (g) Species or species group of fish or shellfish sold;

50 (h) Quantity in pounds;

51 (i) Price received per pound;

52 (j) Signature of the individual preparing the fish ticket;

53 (k) Name of wholesale fish dealer to whom other food fish or shellfish were sold from the same
54 fishing trip.

55 (l) For troll-caught salmon, fish receiving tickets shall show the number **of each species of salmon**
56 **landed, the number of halibut landed, if any, and the number** of days fished during the trip in which
57 the salmon were caught.

58 (3) The original of each Fish Receiving Ticket covering fish and shellfish sold per trip shall be
59 forwarded within ten working days following the landing to the Department.

68 measures as adopted by the **Pacific Fishery Management Council** in its annual **Ocean Salmon**
69 **Management Measures and Impacts**, as finalized in April **2015**[2014], and in addition to the extent
70 they are consistent with these rules, **Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Title 50, Part 660, Subparts**
71 **A and H**.

72 (3) This rule also incorporates by reference the **Oregon Sport Fishing Regulations**.
