**Second Alternative for**  
**Sale of Taxidermy Mounts**  
**Division 200**  
**Proposed OAR's**

The discussion of revisions to the sale of taxidermy mounts was outlined on page 4 of the Staff Proposals (Attachment 3). The proposed revisions presented during the public meetings only included an option for individuals 65 years of age or older to sell taxidermy mounts of big game they had harvested. Since the Department did not receive any significant feedback on the issue and recognizing that there would certainly be other life circumstances where individuals may want to sell their taxidermy mounts, we are presenting a second alternative. This alternative is less restrictive and would not have an age threshold on who could sell their taxidermy mounts. Other provisions of the rule are the same as originally proposed including fees for registration permit and providing the Department with evidence of the legal harvest of the game mammal by the seller or a decedent.
