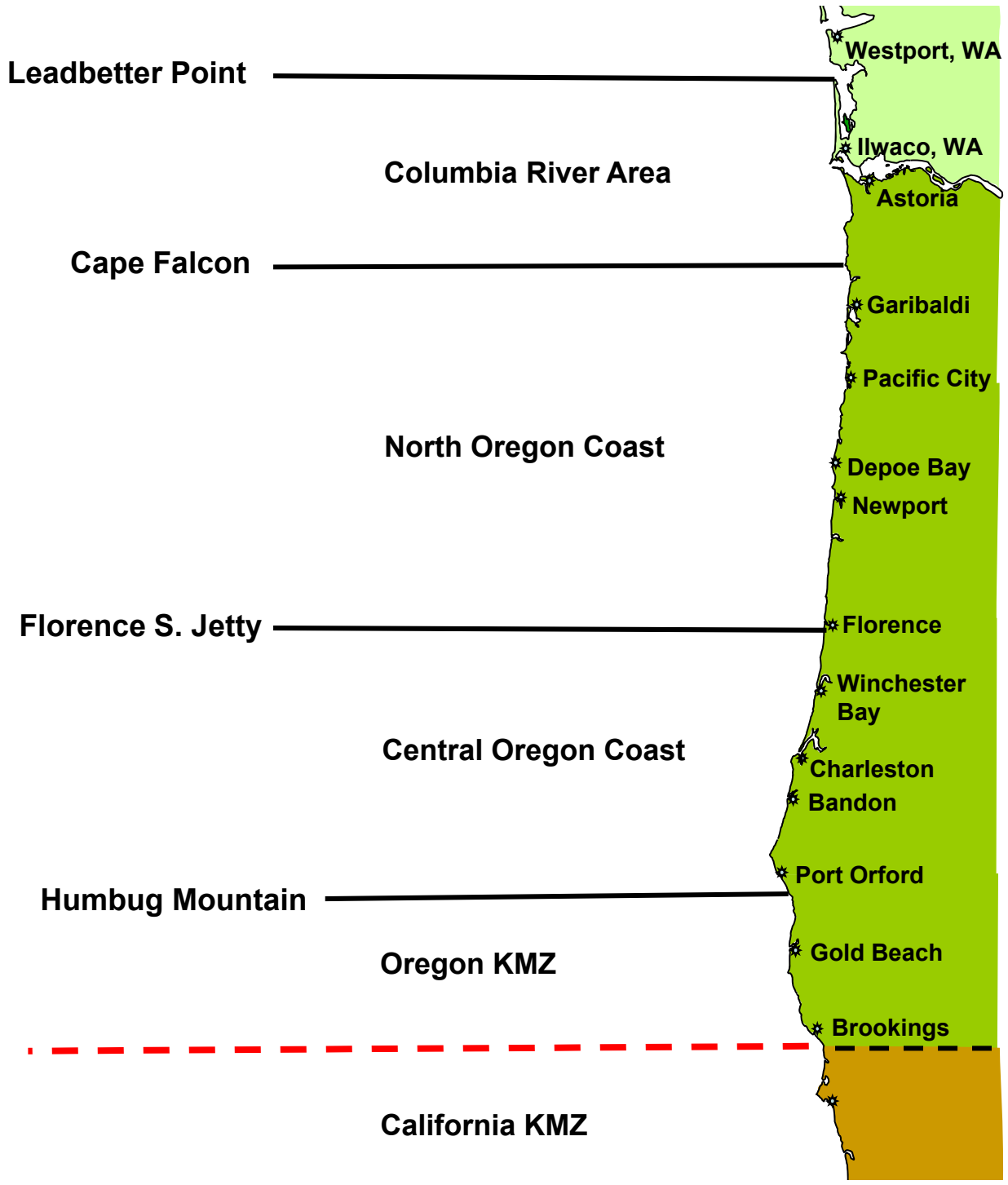

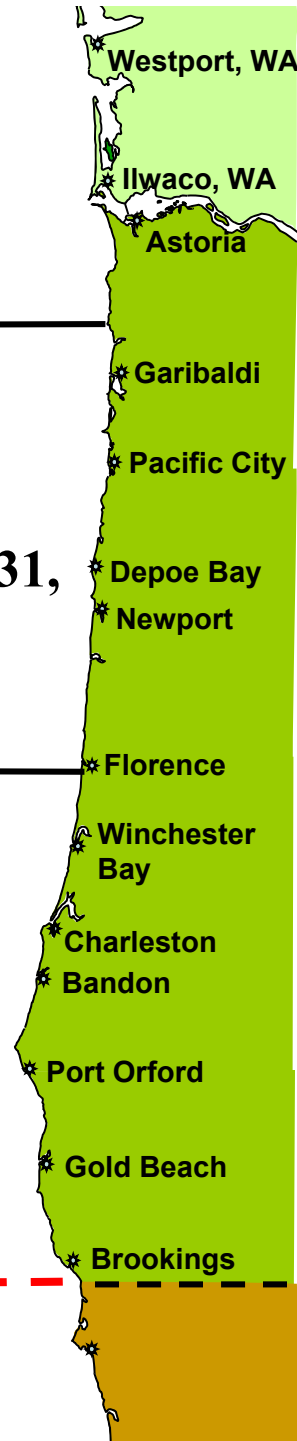
**North of Falcon Troll (p 1 - 2)**  
**May 1- June 30 Chinook (27,000 quota); July 1-4 and 7-19 Chinook and coho (18,000 Chinook and 5,600 coho quota).**

**South of Cape Falcon Troll (Chinook only)**  
**C. Falcon to Florence S. Jetty (p 3-4)**  
**Apr. 15-May 31, June 7-12, June 15-30, July 8-31, Sept. 1-Oct. 31 shoreward of 40-fa only**

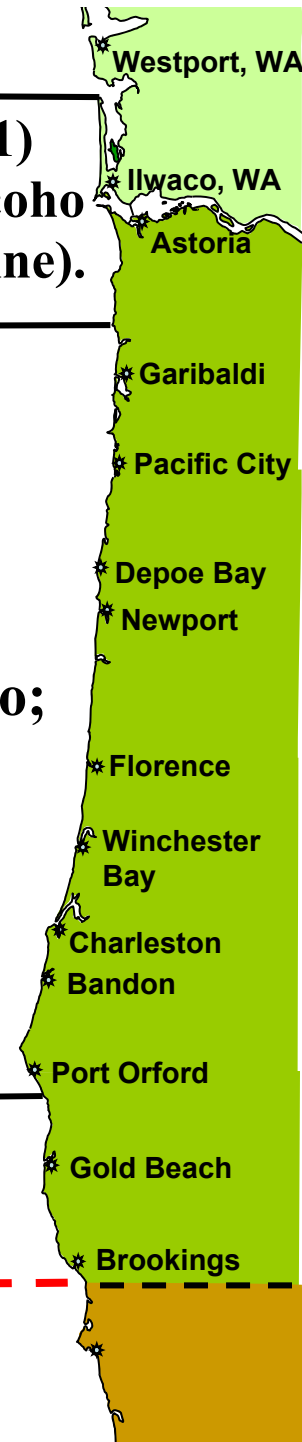
**Florence S. Jetty south to OR/CA border (p 4)**  
**Closed**



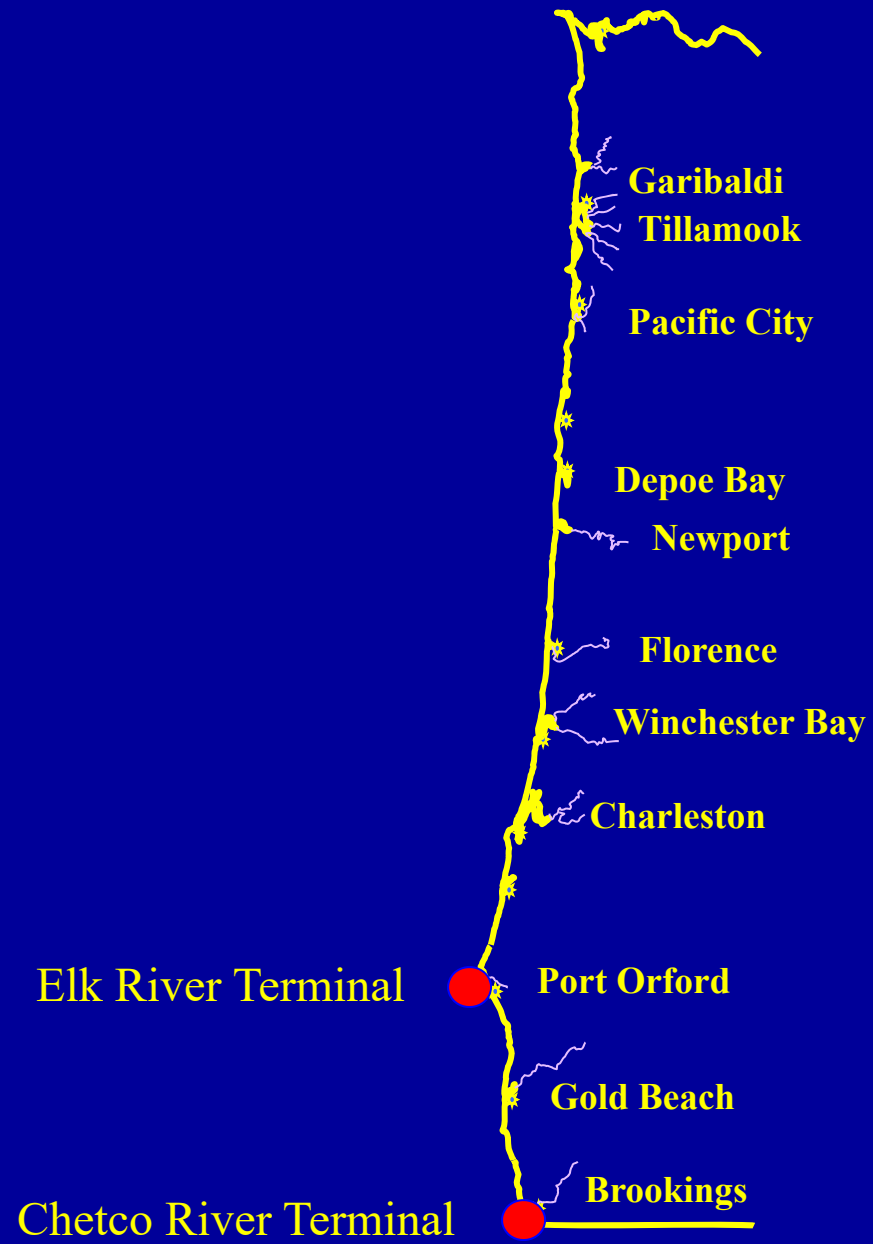
**North of Falcon Sport - Columbia R. Subarea (p 11)**  
**June 24-Sept. 30 Chinook and mark-selective coho**  
**(21,000 coho quota and 13,200 Chinook guideline).**

**Falcon to Humbug Sport (p 13-14)**  
**Mar. 15-Oct. 31 Chinook;**  
**June 24-July 31 or 18K mark-selective coho;**  
**Sept. 2-30 or 6K non-mark-selective coho**  
**Closed outside of 40-fa in October**

**South of Humbug Sport (p 14)**  
**Closed**

Elk

Sport- 2 Chinook per day, only 1 wild. 10 wild seasonal aggregate.

Nov. 1-30 (open in Oct. under PFMC) [no change to OAR needed]

Commercial- Oct. 15-Nov. 30, 20 fish daily landing limit. 26 inch size limit.

\*Addition of Oct. 15 to commercial – no PFMC commercial opportunity in this area.

## Staff Recommendations for 2017 Ocean Terminal Areas

---

Area	Staff Recommendation
Chetco	Sport- <u>1/day</u> ; Oct 7-8 and 14-15. <u>Minimum size 28"</u> .

Commercial- Oct. 9-13 and 16-31 or 300 chinook quota, 5 fish per day landing limit for October 9-13 and 10 fish per day landing limit thereafter. Minimum size 28".

\*Openers for both fisheries delayed, and increased minimum size in sport to limit risk of Klamath stock 'credit card' to 2018 seasons.
