Dear Interested Party:

The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife is evaluating the status of the Marbled Murrelet in Oregon. This status review is in response to a petition from several conservation groups. The petition requests that the seabird be reclassified from threatened to endangered (uplisted) under the Oregon Endangered Species Act.

At its upcoming meeting on June 9<sup>th</sup> in Salem, the Oregon Fish and Wildlife Commission will receive a briefing from staff on the Marbled Murrelet status review and associated rulemaking process. Staff will provide an update on consultation with interested and affected parties, progress made on the biological status review, and proposed next steps. The Commission will be asked to approve a 12-month extension to allow completion of the status review report and rulemaking process by June 21, 2018.
