6 **635-008-0050**7 **Fish and Wildlife Commission to Post and Enforce Rules**

8 In compliance with authority contained in ORS 496.146(9), and penalties prescribed in 496.992, the
9 following rules are adopted to protect wildlife, fish, lands, and appurtenances or management activities
10 and objectives on lands where title to, or control of, rests in the State of Oregon, acting by and through its
11 Department of Fish and Wildlife ("**Department owned, managed, or controlled areas**"). In addition to
12 the requirements and restrictions contained in chapter 635, divisions 011, 021, 045, 046, 050, 051, 052,
13 053, 054, [and]060, **and 065,**[;] the following rules shall apply to all Department [~~wildlife~~]**owned,**
14 **managed, or controlled** areas referenced in chapter 635, division 008 except as modified by the rules for
15 individual [~~wildlife~~]areas.

16 (1) In order to further the purposes of ORS 496.012 or to protect public safety, portions of [~~wildlife~~]
17 **Department owned, managed, or controlled** areas may be posted and closed to all entry. Entering an
18 area posted "closed to entry" is prohibited except by permit.

19 (2) Leaving garbage and litter on the area is prohibited.

20 (3) Posted Refuges and Safety Zones are closed to hunting and shooting.

21 (4) Motor vehicles are prohibited except on parking areas, [~~and~~]open roads, **areas posted as open to**
22 **motor vehicles**, or as provided for in the following rules. No cross country travel or off road motor
23 vehicle use is allowed, except by ODFW issued permit or for administrative use.

24 (5) A permit is required to remove firewood, cut trees, dig or remove [~~artifacts or archeological~~
25 ~~specimens,~~minerals, sand, gravel, rock, or any other article, product or material found on the area except
26 for fish and wildlife taken as permitted by law and edible fruiting bodies of plants for personal
27 consumption.

28 (6) An agreement is required to graze livestock except riding and pack animals in actual use for
29 recreational purposes. Trespass livestock may be removed and/or impounded at the owner's expense in
30 compliance with ORS Chapter 607.

31 (7) No person shall display behavior which unreasonably deters, distracts or hinders others in the
32 peaceable enjoyment of the area.

33 (8) The Department may evict any person from [~~the~~]**an** area for any violation of any Department rule
34 or regulation, or when continued presence of that person could cause a threat to the rights and safety of
35 others or property.

36 (9) No person, commercial vendor or company shall dispense or sell material, goods or items on the
37 area, except by permit.

1 (10) Drones/UAV's may not be flown within the boundary of any Wildlife Area except for
2 administrative use or by permit issued by ODFW.

3 (11) The Department may manage, control or humanely remove any non-native or invasive species
4 from [~~lands owned or managed by the~~]Department **owned, managed, or controlled areas** for the purpose
5 of protecting native wildlife and their habitats.

6 **(12) All dogs must be kept on a leash, except:**

7 **(a) While accompanied by a licensed hunter when being used to hunt game birds, including**
8 **while going to or coming from hunting locations;**

9 **(b) In a posted dog training area;**

10 **(c) While the dog is under direct control in a posted parking area, designated campground or on**
11 **a road currently open to public motor vehicle traffic; or**

12 **(d) As otherwise specified in 635-008-0112, 0147, 0190, 0211.**

13 **(13) It is unlawful to dig and disturb any artifact or archeological specimen on any public land**
14 **per ORS Chapter 358 and federal law under the Archaeological Resources Protection Act of 1979.**

15 **(14) Possession and use of fireworks, explosives, or similar materials is prohibited.**

16 **(15[42])** The Department may issue access permits allowing exceptions to these rules for uses or
17 activities compatible with the purpose of each [~~wildlife~~]area, and consistent with the goals and objectives
18 of the[~~ir~~] respective [Wildlife Area] [M]management [P]plan where applicable.

23 **Bridge Creek Wildlife Area (Umatilla County)**

24 The Bridge Creek Wildlife Area is open to wildlife-oriented public use compatible with the goals and
25 objectives contained in the 2009 Bridge Creek Wildlife Area Management Plan unless otherwise
26 excluded or restricted by the following rules:

27 (1) The area is open to entry during the period April 15 through November 30, except by access permit
28 issued by ODFW.

29 (2) Motorized vehicle travel is only allowed on open roads or parking areas and up to 300 feet off open
30 roads for the purpose of moving to and from campsites.

31 (3) Camping is allowed during the period April 15 through November 30, and **shall** [~~may~~] not exceed **a**
32 **total of 14 days** [~~per stay~~] **during any 30-day period.**

33 (4) Campfires or open burning is prohibited except at campsites. Open fires are prohibited during
34 designated fire closures.

2 **Coquille Valley Wildlife Area (Coos County)**

3 The Coquille Valley Wildlife Area is open for wildlife-oriented public use compatible with the goals
4 and objectives contained in the 2016 Coquille Valley Wildlife Area Management Plan (the "Plan") unless
5 otherwise excluded or restricted by the following rules. The Wildlife Area Goals and Objectives in the
6 Plan are incorporated into this rule by reference.

7 (1) Free daily Hunting/Access permits are required, must be possessed at all times by users and must
8 be completed and returned at the end of the day. Consult annual Game Bird regulations for time and date
9 restrictions and hunting requirements.

10 (2) Discharging firearms is prohibited except as authorized during game bird and game mammal
11 seasons, or by access permit issued by ODFW.

12 ~~[(3) All dogs must be on a leash except when used in the pursuit or retrieval of game during authorized~~
13 ~~game bird seasons, or by access permit issued by ODFW.]~~

14 ~~(3[4])~~ No person shall possess or use any shot other than federally-approved nontoxic shot at any time,
15 except for big game hunters using buckshot or slugs.

16 ~~(4[5])~~ Discharge of firearms into, from or across Safety Zones is prohibited.

17 ~~(5[6])~~ Posted Refuges are closed to public access except to retrieve lawfully taken wildlife during
18 authorized hunting seasons, or by access permit issued by ODFW.

19 ~~(6[7])~~ Camping and/or open fires are prohibited.

20 ~~(7[8])~~ The wildlife area is closed to the public 10 pm to 4 am.

21 ~~(8[9])~~ Any vehicle found parked or unattended on the Wildlife Area between the hours of 10 pm and 4
22 am, or obstructing public or administrative access may be towed at the expense of the registered owner or
23 owners.

24 ~~(9[10])~~ Parking is allowed in designated areas only.

25 ~~(10[11])~~ No boats with gas powered motors may be launched from the area except by access permit
26 issued by ODFW.

32 The Coyote Springs Wildlife Area is open to wildlife-oriented public use compatible with the goals
33 and objectives contained in the 2008 Columbia Basin Wildlife Area Management Plan unless otherwise
34 excluded or restricted by the following rules:

35 ~~[(4) All dogs must be on a leash except during authorized game bird hunting seasons, or by access~~
36 ~~permit issued by ODFW.]~~

- 1 (1[2]) Camping or overnight stay is prohibited.
- 2 (2[3]) Open fires are prohibited.
- 3 (3[4]) Discharging firearms other than shotguns is prohibited except as authorized by access permit
4 issued by ODFW.
- 5 (4[5]) Discharging a shotgun is prohibited except as authorized during game bird seasons.
- 6 (5[6]) No person shall possess or use any shot other than federally-approved nontoxic shot.

17 **Ken Denman Wildlife Area (Jackson County)**

18 The Ken Denman (Denman) Wildlife Area is open to wildlife-oriented public use compatible with the
19 goals and objectives contained in the 2006 Ken Denman Wildlife Area Management Plan unless otherwise
20 excluded or restricted by the following rules:

21 (1) Open to the discharge of firearms only while hunting big game and game birds during authorized
22 seasons, or by access permit issued by ODFW.

23 (2) No person shall possess or use any shot other than federally-approved nontoxic shot at any time,
24 except for big game hunters using buckshot or slugs.

25 (3) Use of rifles and handguns is prohibited at all times.

26 ~~[(4) Running or training of dogs is prohibited April 1 through July 31 except on designated Dog
27 Training Areas or by access permit issued by ODFW.]~~

28 (4[5]) Camping is prohibited except by access permit issued by ODFW.

29 (5[6]) Boats with gas propelled motors are prohibited.

30 (6[7]) The use of air guns, BB guns and paintball guns is prohibited.

31 (7[8]) Free daily hunting permits available at self-service check stations located at area access points
32 are required, must be possessed at all times by users and must be completed and returned at the end of the
33 day.

34 (8[9]) Trapping is prohibited except by access permit issued by ODFW.

35 (9[10]) ODFW Wildlife Area Parking Permit required.

5 **Elkhorn Wildlife Area (Baker/Union Counties)**

6 The Elkhorn Wildlife Area is open to wildlife-oriented public use compatible with the goals and
7 objectives contained in the 2006 Elkhorn Wildlife Area Management Plan unless otherwise excluded or
8 restricted by the following rules:

9 (1) The area is open to the public from April 11 through November 30.

10 (2) Camping is allowed during the period April 11 through November 30, and shall ~~[may]~~ not exceed
11 a total of 14 days during any 30-day period.

12 (3) Campfires or open burning is prohibited except at campsites. Open fires are prohibited during
13 designated fire closures.

14 ~~[(4) Dogs are prohibited from running at large.]~~

15 (4~~5~~) ATV and snowmobile use is prohibited on all area lands except for administrative use or by
16 access permit issued by ODFW.

17 (5~~6~~) The Roth Tract is closed to all hunting. The Roth Tract is closed to public entry at all times of
18 the year except by access permit issued by ODFW.

24 **Fern Ridge Wildlife Area (Lane County)**

25 As the underlying landowner, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has adopted rules and regulations
26 (CFR Title 36) that apply to all Fern Ridge project land and water areas. The Fern Ridge Wildlife Area is
27 open to wildlife-oriented public use compatible with the goals and objectives contained in the 2009 Fern
28 Ridge Wildlife Area Management Plan unless otherwise excluded or restricted by the following rules:

29 (1) Open to the discharge of firearms only while hunting big game and game birds during authorized
30 seasons, or by access permit issued by ODFW.

31 (2) Discharging rifles and handguns is prohibited.

32 (3) No person shall possess or use any shot other than federally-approved nontoxic shot at any time,
33 except for big game hunters using buckshot or slugs.

34 (4) The use of air guns, BB guns and paintball guns is prohibited.

35 ~~[(5) All dogs must be on a leash except during authorized hunting seasons, or by access permit issued
36 by ODFW.]~~

1 (5[6]) Camping is prohibited except by access permit issued by ODFW.

2 (6[7]) Open fires are prohibited.

3 (7[8]) The wildlife area is closed to the public 10 pm to 4 am.

4 (8[9]) Horses and horseback riding are prohibited except by access permit issued by ODFW.

6 possessed at all times by users and must be completed and returned at the end of the day. Consult annual
7 Game Bird regulations for check station locations, time and date restrictions, and hunting requirements.

8 (10[11]) Seasonal access restrictions may be in place to provide wildlife sanctuary. Consult annual
9 Game Bird Regulations and posted signage for dates and locations.

10 (11[12]) Trapping is prohibited except by access permit issued by ODFW.

11 (12[13]) ODFW Wildlife Area Parking Permit required.

20 ~~[(1) All dogs must be on a leash except during authorized game bird hunting seasons, or by access~~
21 ~~permit issued by ODFW.]~~

22 (1[2]) Camping or overnight stay is prohibited.

23 (2[3]) Horses must stay on the Lewis and Clark Heritage trail.

24 (3[4]) Trapping is prohibited except by access permit issued ODFW.

25 (4[5]) Open fires are prohibited.

26 (5[6]) Discharging firearms other than shotguns is prohibited except as authorized by an access
27 permit issued by ODFW.

28 (6[7]) Discharging a shotgun is prohibited except as authorized during game bird and game mammal

8 restricted by the following rules:

9 (1) Open to the discharge of firearms only while hunting big game and game birds during authorized
10 seasons, or by access permit issued by ODFW.

11 (2) Posted Refuges and Safety Zones are closed to public access

12 (3) Camping is prohibited except in designated areas and shall not exceed a total of 14 days during
13 any 30-day period, [~~or by access permit issued by ODFW.~~]

14 [~~(4) Running of dogs is prohibited.~~]

15 (4[5]) The Beneke Tract is open for hunting only during authorized game mammal and game bird
16 seasons. Posted portions of the Beneke Tract are closed to entry during any open Saddle Mountain Unit
17 elk season, except for black-tailed deer hunting only during the general western Oregon rifle season with
18 a valid unused tag, or by access permit issued by ODFW.

19 (5[6]) The Humbug tract is open for hunting only during authorized game mammal and game bird
20 seasons. Shooting firearms and bows from or across open fields is prohibited during any open Wilson
21 Unit elk season.

32 (1) Discharging firearms is prohibited except as authorized during game bird seasons, or by access
33 permit issued by ODFW.

34 [~~(2) Running or training of dogs is prohibited February 1 through August 31 except on designated~~
35 ~~Dog Training Areas or by access permit issued by ODFW.~~]

36 (2[3]) Camping is prohibited.

- 1 (3[4]) Personal property must be removed from the area at the end of each hunt day.
- 2 (4[5]) No person shall possess or use any shot other than federally-approved nontoxic shot at any
3 time.
- 4 (5[6]) Miller Island Unit is closed to all deer hunting.

20 or restricted by the following rules:

- 21 (1) All wildlife area lands, except those west of Foothill Road, are closed to public entry except
22 Wed., Sat., Sun. and Federal holidays August 1 through January 31 with the following exceptions:
23 (a) The Nature Trail, adjacent to I-84, is open year-round;
24 (b) The Foothill Road Viewpoint is open year-round;
25 (c) The Peach Road Fishing Pond is open year-round;

- 28 (2) All lands west of Foothill Road are closed to all entry Feb. 1 through March 31, except by access

- 30 (3) A daily public access permit, is required, must be possessed at all times by users and must be
31 completed and returned at the end of the day.
- 32 (4) The wildlife area is closed to the public between 10 pm and 4 am.
- 33 (5) Open to the discharge of firearms only while hunting during authorized game bird and big game
34 hunting seasons, or by permit. Discharge of all handgun and centerfire or rimfire rifles is prohibited east
35 of Foothill Road. Discharge of air guns, BB guns, and paintball guns is prohibited at all times.
- 36 (6) Camping is prohibited.

13 The Lower Deschutes Wildlife Area is open to wildlife-oriented public use compatible with the goals
14 and objectives contained in the 2009 Lower Deschutes Wildlife Area Management Plan unless otherwise
15 excluded or restricted by the Deschutes River Scenic Waterway Rules and the following additional rules:

16 (1) Open to the discharge of firearms only while hunting big game and game birds during authorized
17 seasons or by permit; except that discharge of firearms is prohibited within the scenic waterway boundary
18 from the third Saturday in May through August 31.

19 (2) Unauthorized motor vehicle use is prohibited.

20 (3) Horses and horseback riding are prohibited except by access permit issued by OPRD.

21 (4) Open fires are prohibited except as specified under the Scenic Waterway rules.

22 ~~[(5) Running or training of dogs is prohibited except during authorized game bird hunting seasons.]~~

23 ~~(5[6])~~ Camping is prohibited on river islands, areas posted "camping prohibited" within the Deschutes
24 River Scenic Waterway, and on state lands outside the Deschutes River Scenic Waterway in the Lower
25 Deschutes Wildlife Area (Deschutes Scenic Waterway is an area extending 1/4-mile away from each bank
26 of the river). Exception: Camping is allowed on the Woosley Tract from three days prior to the opening

2 **St. Louis Ponds (Marion County)**

3 (1) St. Louis Ponds is that area of posted Department lands located in Sections 21, 22, 27, and 28,
4 Township 5 South, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian in Marion County and containing 222 acres
5 more or less.

6 (2) In the area described in section (1) of this rule it is unlawful to:

7 (a) Use the area for any purpose between one hour after sunset and one hour before sunrise;

8 (b) Use any floating craft on any pond;

9 (c) Swim or otherwise enter any pond;

10 (d) Build open fires;
