Petition to Amend A Rule

Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife

IN THE MATTER OF THE AMENDMENT OF) Petition to Amend
OAR 635-060-0023 ESTABLISHING PREFERENCE) OAR 635-060-0023(6)
POINTS FOR PIONEER LICENSE HOLDERS) (Pioneer Reset Points)

1. Petitioner's name and address is John Anderson, 1668 'NE' Terrace Drive, Grants Pass, Oregon.
2. Petitioner is currently retired after 28 years with the Oregon State Police and 12 years with Court Security for the United States Marshals Service. Petitioner has just purchased his first Pioneer Combined License having been born in and resided in Oregon for 65 years, and fished and hunted for over 50 of those years. Petitioner has two older brothers with the same heritage, a heritage that has been and is being passed on to others.
3. Under OAR 635-060-0023 (6), Petitioner, as a Pioneer License Holder, will have preference points reset to one if successful in a controlled hunt drawing.
4. Petitioner asserts that OAR 635-060-0023 (6) which established a Pioneer License holder reset on successful controlled hunt drawings to one does not accomplish the original goal of the rule as established in 2011. When the commission adopted the rule in 2011, the single preference point allowed most Pioneer License holders to hunt their desired deer or elk hunt. The single point reset no longer affords the Pioneer Hunter a reasonable assurance of success during the later years of life. Most controlled hunts now need many more preference points to be successful than what was needed in 2011 when the commission adopted the one point reset.

ORS 496.146 Additional Powers of Commission
In addition to any other duties or powers provided by law, the State
Wildlife Commission:

(17) Shall establish a preference system so that individuals who are unsuccessful in controlled hunt permit drawings for deer and elk hunting have a reasonable assurance of success in those drawings in subsequent years. In establishing the preference system, the commission shall consider giving additional preference points to persons who have been issued a resident annual pioneer combination license pursuant to ORS 497.132 (Combined Licenses for Residents)

5. Petitioner proposes that OAR 635-060-0023 (6) be amended to show the reset for Pioneer License holders be set at a minimum of three.
6. OAR 635-060-0023 (6) as petitioner proposes to amend, it would read as follows:
Applicants, except for those with a Pioneer Angling/Hunting License, successful in drawing their first choice hunt except numbers ending in 99 within a hunt number series shall have zero preference points when they next apply for a tag in that hunt number series. Successful Applicants with a Pioneer Angling/Hunting license shall have three ~~one~~ preference points when they apply for a tag in that hunt number series.
7. Petitioner will be providing signatures of many individuals who have shown a particular interest in the proposed amendment of OAR 635-060-0023.

Wherefore, petitioner requests the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife Commission to adopt the proposed amendment to OAR 635-060-0023.

Petition to Amend OAR 635-060-0023

Discussion Points

During the calendar year 2010 the ODFW Commission began discussions regarding reset points on controlled hunt drawings for Pioneer Angling/Hunting license hunters that were successful in drawing a controlled hunt.

ORS 496.146 lists additional powers of the ODFW Commission and sets forth mandates for the Commission to pursue, ORS 496.146 specifically provides that in addition to any other duties or powers provided by law, the State Wildlife Commission:

This discussion relates specifically to the ruling subsection:

(17) Shall establish a preference system so that individuals who are unsuccessful in controlled hunt permit drawings for deer and elk hunting have a reasonable assurance of success in those drawings in subsequent years. In establishing the preference system, the commission shall consider giving additional preference points to persons who have been issued a resident annual pioneer combination license pursuant to ORS 497.132 (Combined Licenses for Residents)

For the sake of discussion I would like to point out and highlight the fact that the Commission was given the authority to consider giving additional preference **POINTS**, not point, to the mentioned licensed holders. The Commission was not restricted in the number of preference points to be issued.

When OAR 635-060-0023, subsection (6) was adopted and passed it was based on information and concerns that had been brought before the Commissioners. After considering the information provided the Commission's decision was to act by providing a single point reset to the Pioneer Combined License holder that was successful in the controlled hunt draw.

One of the concerns the Commission had discussed was the impact the rule would have on the average hunter applying for a controlled hunt draw. How many years would the rule add to the normal applicant in any specific controlled hunt draw.

This question was difficult to consider because there was no history or statistical data available to accurately reflect what the impact might be. The decision was therefore made to put the reset number at one and develop a system to monitor the impact of the rule in subsequent years. This specific rule, implemented in calendar year 2011, has now been in effect for seven hunting seasons involving controlled hunts requiring a successful draw to be able to hunt a given unit.

Because the statistics addressing the Commission's concerns in 2011 to 2018 are not easily accessed by the normal hunting public it makes it a difficult prospect to then argue for an increase in the number of reset points given to the Pioneer Combined License holder.

With this lack of information, we are then in a position to argue based on what we do know to be true, minus specific facts.

The truth, in my opinion, is that the Commission was originally tasked with the responsibility to consider and evaluate providing a privilege to the Oregon Pioneer hunters. The privilege was provided because the Pioneer Combined License holder has been residing in and been involved in hunting Oregon for at least 50 years. The Oregon Pioneer is now at the end of his hunting experiences, with fewer years left to be hunting the areas they have grown up hunting. Those remaining years of hunting are more limited for some than others, but they are certainly shorter for every Pioneer Hunter that has made hunting a heritage and taught those behind them the joy and love of hunting.

In 2011, when the Commission Amended OAR 635-060-0023, most Pioneer Combined License holders were successful on their chosen hunt with the single preference point. That is not the case for the Pioneer Hunter anymore. Now it takes many more preference points to be successful in the draw of choice. When the reset was first implemented, in the area of my hunt of choice, one point was sufficient for a successful draw. Currently, due to more hunting pressure, three points might provide a successful draw.

It is my firm belief that the intent of the Commission, by implementing OAR 635-060-0023, was to provide a substantial privilege to the Pioneer Hunter so that they might be able to end their Hunting years with the opportunity to be successful. I





