**RE: Letter of Support – Anderson Property Acquisition**

Dear Commissioners,

Ducks Unlimited (DU) supports Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) proposed purchase of the 200-acre Anderson property in Klamath Falls. This property shares a common border with ODFW's Klamath Wildlife Area Miller Island Unit and would be an excellent addition to Miller Island. This potential acquisition provides a rare opportunity to purchase land adjoining Miller Island from a willing seller who has managed the land for wildlife benefit and recreation.

The property includes a mixture of seasonal wetland and upland habitats and can be enhanced to provide excellent nesting and brood-rearing opportunities in the spring-summer and migration habitat in the fall and spring. In addition to its value to wildlife, we appreciate the opportunities that the Anderson property could provide to increase public access and recreation, particularly public hunting. We understand that funds for this proposed acquisition would come from Oregon waterfowl stamp sales, and support the use of these funds for this acquisition. We also support ODFW's interest to increase public recreation and hunting in this region of Oregon, while also looking to create positive economic benefits to the Klamath Falls community and Klamath County.

Ducks Unlimited encourages the Commission's approval of this acquisition, and we look forward to partnering with ODFW in future habitat enhancement and outreach actions that may be needed.
