635-008-0050

Fish and Wildlife Commission to Post and Enforce Rules

In compliance with authority contained in ORS 496.146(9), and penalties prescribed in 496.992, the following rules are adopted to protect wildlife, fish, lands, and appurtenances or management activities and objectives on lands where title to, or control of, rests in the State of Oregon, acting by and through its Department of Fish and Wildlife ("Department owned, managed, or controlled areas"). In addition to the requirements and restrictions contained in chapter 635, divisions 011, 021, 045, 046, 050, 051, 052, 053, 054, 060, and 065, the following rules shall apply to all Department owned, managed, or controlled areas referenced in chapter 635, division 008 except as modified by the rules for individual areas.

(1) In order to further the purposes of ORS 496.012 or to protect public safety, portions of Department owned, managed, or controlled areas may be posted and closed to all entry. Entering an area posted "closed to entry" is prohibited [~~except by permit~~].

(2) Leaving garbage and litter on the area is prohibited.

(3) Leaving personal or commercial property overnight on Department owned, managed or controlled areas is prohibited except at camping sites during authorized camping periods.

~~(4)~~(3) Posted Refuges and Safety Zones are closed to hunting and shooting.

~~(5)~~(4) Motor vehicles are prohibited except on parking areas, open roads, areas posted as open to motor vehicles, or as provided for in the following rules. No cross country travel or off road motor vehicle use is allowed, except [~~by ODFW issued permit or~~]for administrative use.

~~(6)~~(5) A permit is required to remove firewood, cut trees, dig or remove minerals, sand, gravel, rock, or any other article, product or material found on the area except for fish and wildlife taken as permitted by law and edible fruiting bodies of plants for personal consumption.

~~(7)~~(6) An agreement is required to graze livestock except riding and pack animals in actual use for recreational purposes. Trespass livestock may be removed and/or impounded at the owner's expense in compliance with ORS Chapter 607.

~~(8)~~(7) No person shall display behavior which unreasonably deters, distracts or hinders others in the peaceable enjoyment of the area.

~~(9)~~(8) The Department may evict any person from an area for any violation of any Department rule or regulation, or when continued presence of that person could cause a threat to the rights and safety of others or property.

1 (10[9]) No person, commercial vendor or company shall dispense or sell material, goods or items
2 on the area[, ~~except by permit~~].

3 (11[40]) Drones/UAV's may not be flown within the boundary of any ODFW owned, managed,
4 or controlled area except for administrative use [~~or by permit issued by ODFW~~].

5 (12[41]) The Department may manage, control or humanely remove any non-native or invasive
6 species from Department owned, managed, or controlled areas for the purpose of protecting
7 native wildlife and their habitats.

8 (13[42]) All dogs must be kept on a leash, except:

9 (a) While accompanied by a licensed hunter when being used to hunt game birds, including
10 while going to or coming from hunting locations;

11 (b) In a posted dog training area;

12 (c) While the dog is under direct control in a posted parking area, designated campground or on a
13 road currently open to public motor vehicle traffic; or

14 (d) As otherwise specified in 635-008-0112, 0147, 0190, 0211.

15 (14[43]) It is unlawful to dig and disturb any artifact or archeological specimen on any public
16 land per ORS Chapter 358 and federal law under the Archaeological Resources Protection Act of
17 1979.

18 (15[44]) Possession and use of fireworks, explosives, or similar materials is prohibited.

19 (16[45]) The Department may issue access permits allowing exceptions to these rules for uses or
20 activities compatible with the purpose of each area, and consistent with the goals and objectives
21 of the respective management plan where applicable.

26 **Bridge Creek Wildlife Area (Umatilla County)**

27 The Bridge Creek Wildlife Area is open to wildlife-oriented public use compatible with the goals
28 and objectives contained in the 2009 Bridge Creek Wildlife Area Management Plan unless
29 otherwise excluded or restricted by the following rules:

30 (1) The area is open to entry during the period April 15 through November 30[, ~~except by access~~
31 ~~permit issued by ODFW~~].

32 (2) Motorized vehicle travel is only allowed on open roads or parking areas and up to 300 feet
33 off open roads for the purpose of moving to and from campsites.

1 (3) Camping is allowed during the period April 15 through November 30, and shall not exceed a
2 total of 14 days during any 30-day period.

3 (4) Campfires or open burning is prohibited except at campsites. Open fires are prohibited during
4 designated fire closures.

10 The Burns Gravel Pond area is open to public use unless otherwise excluded or restricted by the
11 following rules:

12 (1) Discharging firearms is prohibited.

13 (2) Camping is prohibited.

14 (3) Open fires are prohibited.

15 **(4) The area is closed to the public between 10 pm and 4 am.**

23 (2) Open fires are prohibited except in designated areas.

24 (3) Discharging firearms is prohibited except as authorized during game bird and game mammal
25 seasons[, or by access permit issued by ODFW].

31 The Coquille Valley Wildlife Area is open for wildlife-oriented public use compatible with the
32 goals and objectives contained in the 2016 Coquille Valley Wildlife Area Management Plan (the

1 “Plan”) unless otherwise excluded or restricted by the following rules. The Wildlife Area Goals
2 and Objectives in the Plan are incorporated into this rule by reference.

3 (1) Free daily Hunting/Access permits are required, must be possessed at all times by users and
4 must be completed and returned at the end of the day. Consult annual Game Bird regulations for
5 time and date restrictions and hunting requirements.

6 (2) Discharging firearms is prohibited except as authorized during game bird and game mammal
7 seasons [~~, or by access permit issued by ODFW~~].

8 (3) No person shall possess or use any shot other than federally-approved nontoxic shot at any
9 time, except for big game hunters using buckshot or slugs.

10 (4) Discharge of firearms into, from or across Safety Zones is prohibited.

11 (5) Posted Refuges are closed to public access except to retrieve lawfully taken wildlife during
12 authorized hunting seasons [~~, or by access permit issued by ODFW~~].

13 (6) Camping **is prohibited** [~~and/or open fires are prohibited~~].

14 **(7) Open fires are prohibited.**

15 ~~(8)~~(7) The wildlife area is closed to the public **between** 10 pm [~~tø~~] **and** 4 am.

16 ~~(9)~~(8) Any vehicle found parked or unattended on the Wildlife Area between the hours of 10 pm
17 and 4 am, or obstructing public or administrative access may be towed at the expense of the
18 registered owner or owners.

19 ~~(10)~~(9) Parking is allowed in designated areas only.

20 ~~(11)~~(10) No boats with gas powered motors may be launched from the area [~~except by access~~
21 ~~permit issued by ODFW~~].

3 unless otherwise excluded or restricted by the following rules:

4 (1) Camping or overnight stay is prohibited.

5 (2) Open fires are prohibited.

6 (3) Discharging firearms other than shotguns is prohibited [~~except as authorized by access permit~~
7 ~~issued by ODFW~~].

8 (4) Discharging a shotgun is prohibited except as authorized during game bird seasons.

9 (5) No person shall possess or use any shot other than federally-approved nontoxic shot.

10 (6) The wildlife area is closed to the public between 10 pm and 4 am except in designated
11 parking areas.

12 (7) No person shall leave decoys set out overnight (10 pm to 4 am).

13 (8) Placing waterfowl hunting site closer than 200 yards apart is prohibited.

7 time, except for big game hunters using buckshot or slugs.

8 (3) Use of rifles and handguns is prohibited at all times.

30 designated fire closures.

31 (4) ATV and snowmobile use is prohibited on all area lands except for administrative use [~~or by~~

1 (5) The Roth Tract is closed to all hunting. The Roth Tract is closed to public entry at all times of
2 the year [~~except by access permit issued by ODFW~~].

30 (2) Discharging rifles and handguns is prohibited.

31 (3) No person shall possess or use any shot other than federally-approved nontoxic shot at any
32 time, except for big game hunters using buckshot or slugs.

33 (4) The use of air guns, BB guns and paintball guns is prohibited.
