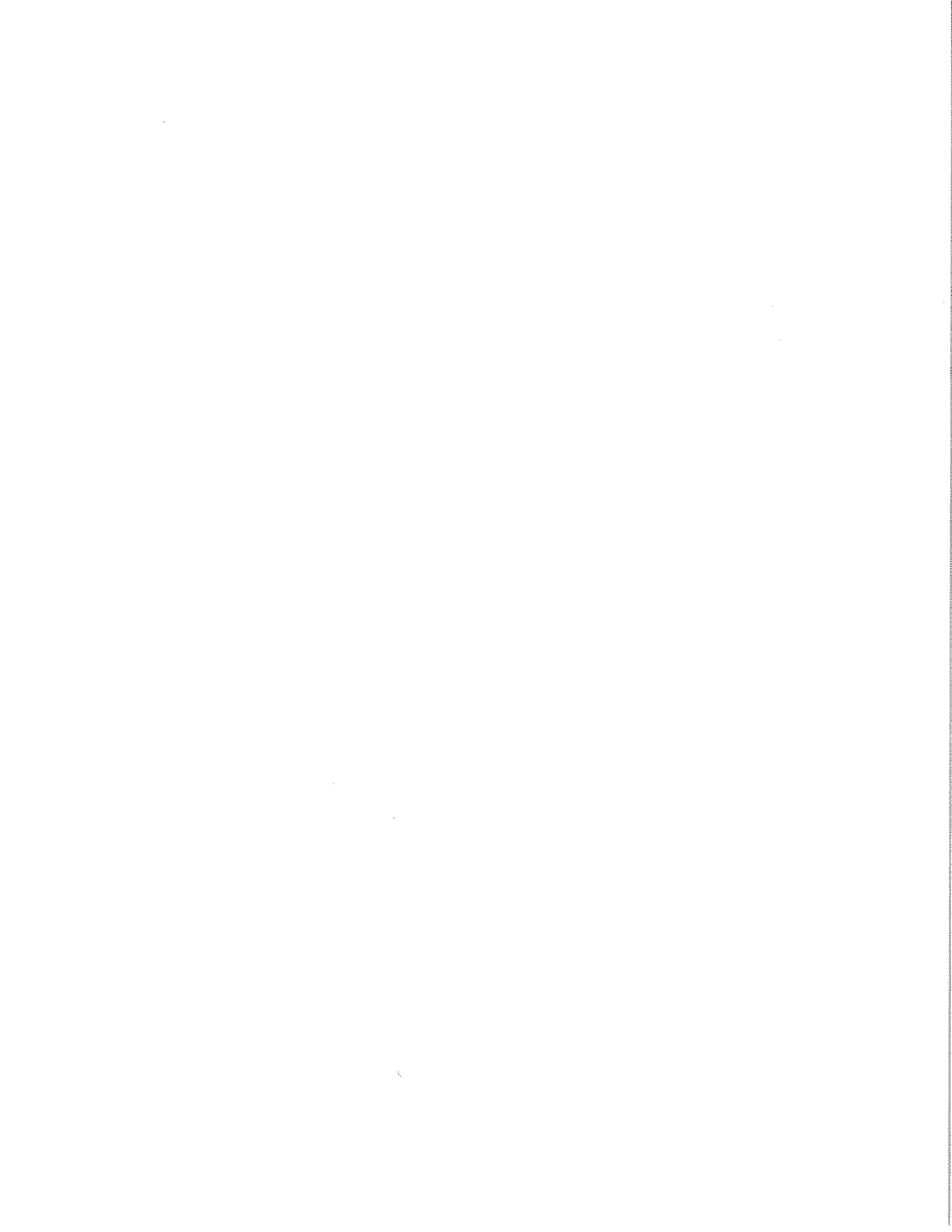


My name is Bill Gunderson and I hold various permits in both the Columbia River gillnet fishery and the ocean troll fishery. These permits were passed down to me by my father William Gunderson Jr. I fished with my father for many years both in Oregon as well as in Alaska. I attended both the University of Oregon and Oregon State University where I graduated from the School of Engineering with a degree in General Civil Engineering in 1980. I recently retired from the board of directors of PND Engineers, Inc., after 37 years with them. I've made Corvallis my home and with our two daughters living here I couldn't be happier.

I am a fourth generation Oregon commercial fisherman with my great grandfather Ole Gunderson homesteading on the Columbia River after emigrating from Norway around the turn of the century. Ole had three sons all who became fishermen on the Columbia River. His youngest son, William senior, was a respected and distinguished fisherman and longshoreman in Astoria, holding president positions in the CRPA and the Local Longshoreman's union. My father Bill Jr. was a terrific fisherman, high school teacher and coach.

I fished with both my grandfather and father on the Columbia River beginning when I was very young. I stayed in the fishery assisting my dad but eventually my career became my principal focus and I only could fish on a limited basis.

After working in Alaska as an engineer for 15 years we opened an office back in our home town of Astoria and this allowed my father and I and my son a chance to gillnet on the river again. It was a joy to spend time together and share some of our favorite drifts with Bill IV who now is an internal medicine doctor in Friday Harbor Washington. While in Astoria I provided some public service as a board member on the Clatsop County Historical Society. Additionally I was a founding developer of the Oregon Fisherman's Cable Committee which pulled the commercial Trawlers into a historic agreement with the submarine fiber optic cable industry. Co-founder Terry Thompson and I have been long time friends since working together on the endeavor.

In closing I do not know what the role is for this position nor the level of commitment however I have worked throughout the world on challenging projects and have a strong connection to the Oregon fishing industries and would be willing and able to provide support to the benefit of the State of Oregon and these fisheries.

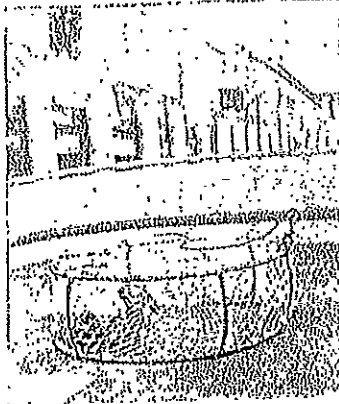
FLEET OF 45-FOOT TROLLERS 1946-BUILT

Twenty-one fishing boats for Pacific coast fishermen and 11 skippers for UNRRA were built during the past two years by the Tacoma Boat-building company.

Of the 21 fishing vessels one was for Astorians. It was built for Ruddy Lovvold and was named Thorevald. She is a 45-footer and is powered by a 100-horsepower Cummins.

Fishing boats built by the company in 1945 were Ocean Spray, 81-foot seiner, for Barney Iverson, Seattle; Signal, 70-foot combination boat, for Olaf Junggaard, Seattle; Voyager, 83-foot seiner, for Joe, John and Pete Auelch, Clir Harbor; and Saga, 70-foot combination boat, for Hans Ahne, Seattle.

In 1946 the following fishing boats, all 45-foot trollers, were turned out for west coast fishermen: Karen A. for Stancer Anderson, Seattle; Tody J. for Clarence Anderson, Seattle; Betty J. for Math Johnson, Seattle; Spwan for Adolph Olson, Seattle; Cape Ommanay for John Mjornd, Seattle; Haven for Fred Owen, Seattle; Carle for Martin Nelson, Seattle; and Supreme for Sheryl Anderson, Tacoma. 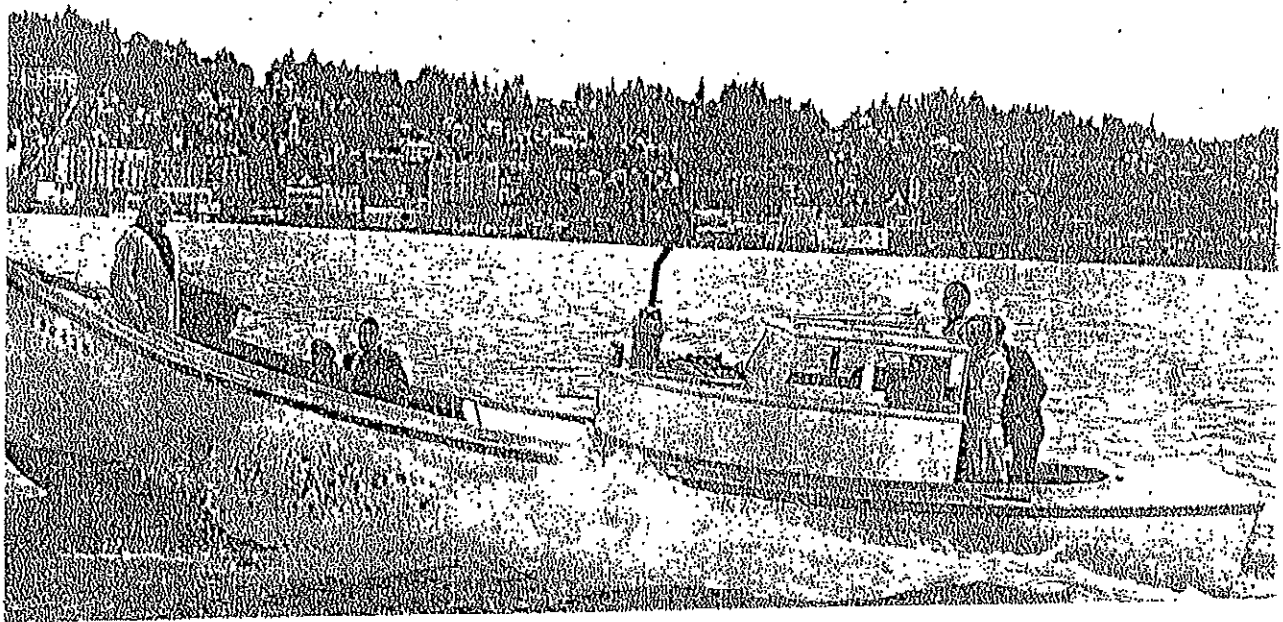

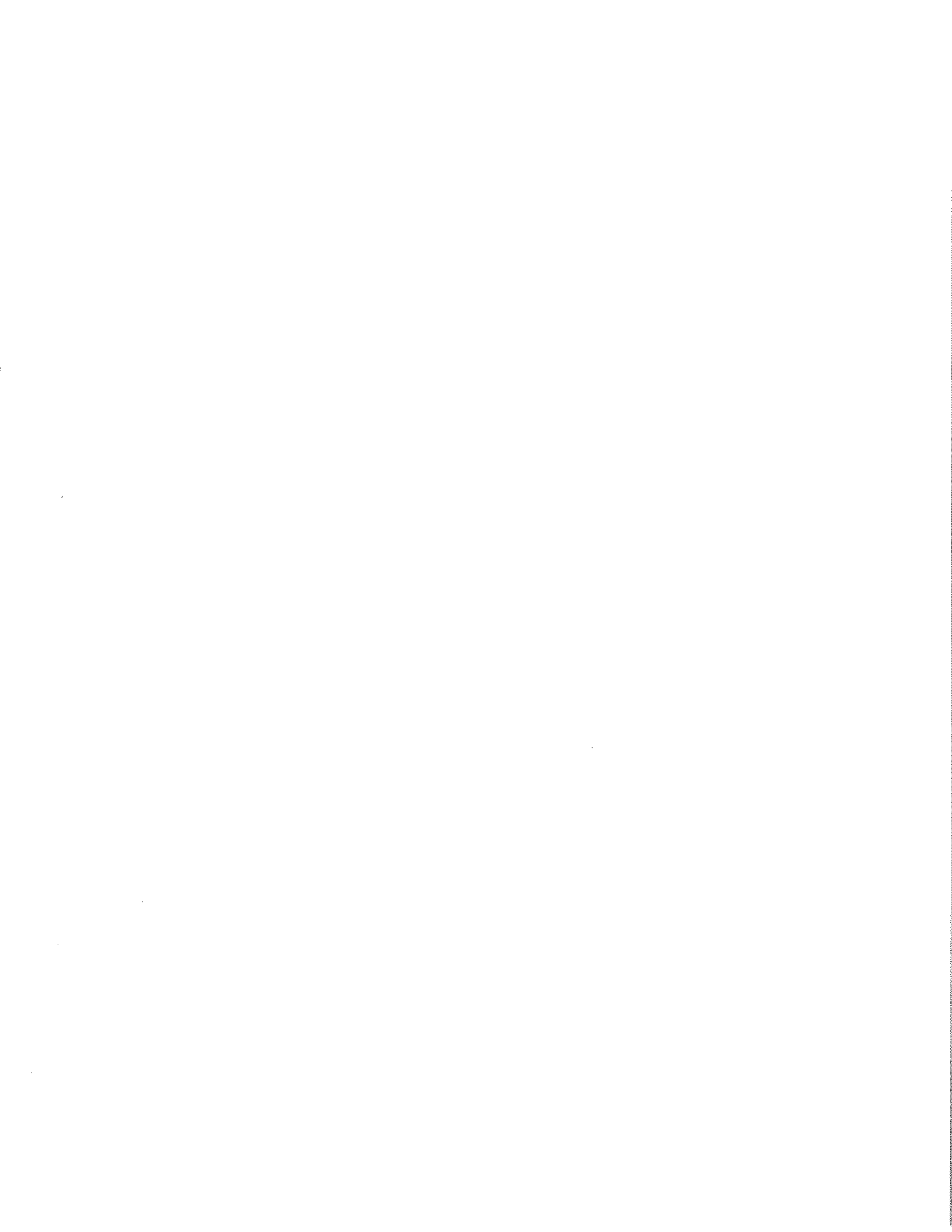
The Lettie is a typical Blix boat, sturdy, well built and with plenty of free board for the lower river. She has a fir hull. Her engine is a Chrysler Rod Crown 110-horsepower.

Gunderson has fished on the Columbia for many seasons and is one of the best known gillnetters. His new boat may proceed upriver next spring.
