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## Oregon State Action

The state of Oregon took the following actions:

### Select Area Fisheries

#### *Youngs Bay Commercial Salmon Fishery (Zone 7)*

- **Rescind** the following winter and spring season periods:

**Upper Youngs Bay** 11 PM Thursday April 11– 3 AM Friday April 12 (4 hours)

**Youngs Bay** 6 PM-10 PM Thursday April 18 (4 hours)

**Area:** Youngs Bay Select Area

- All other regulations previously adopted on January 29, 2019 remain in effect.
- Permanent regulations including rules related to transportation and lighted buoys remain in effect.

### **FUTURE MEETINGS**

- A Compact hearing may be scheduled early next week to consider modifications to other Select Area commercial fisheries.
- A Joint State hearing is scheduled for 3 PM today via teleconference to consider the lower Columbia River recreational salmon fishery and the Bonneville Pool recreational sturgeon fishery.
