# Issue

---

- Current language in OAR 635-001-0030, directs the Department to collect information and time spent working on other executive state agency's regulatory processes, in accordance with ORS 496.167 and ORS 496.168.
- Informational statements are then sent to the respective agencies.
- Starting in fiscal calendar year 2019, invoice statements are to be generated and sent to the respective agencies.
- The statute and rule do not align.
