- **Must fit specific project criteria**



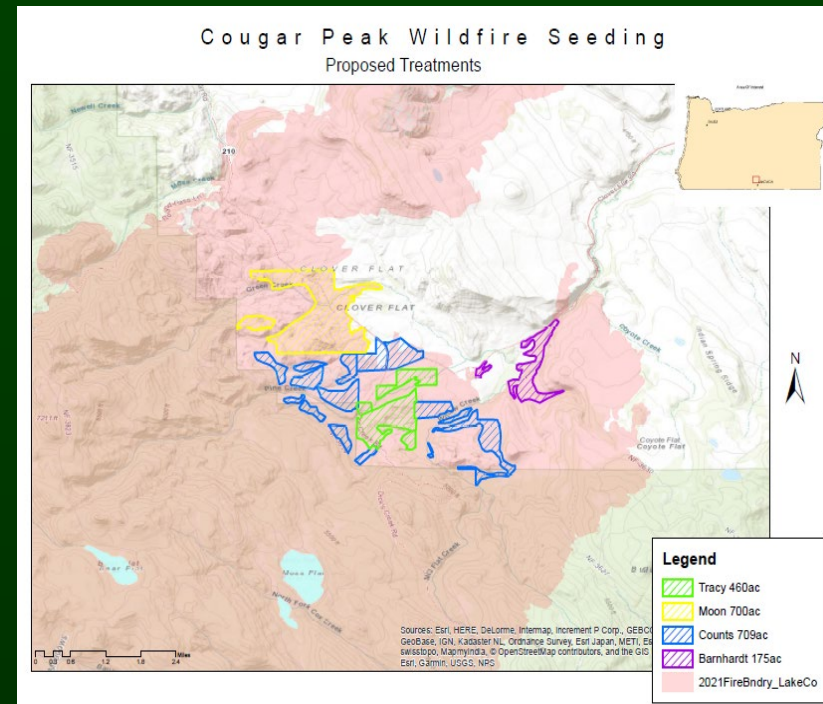
# Grandview Fire Reseeding

# Clover Flat Winter Range/Sage Grouse Rehabilitation

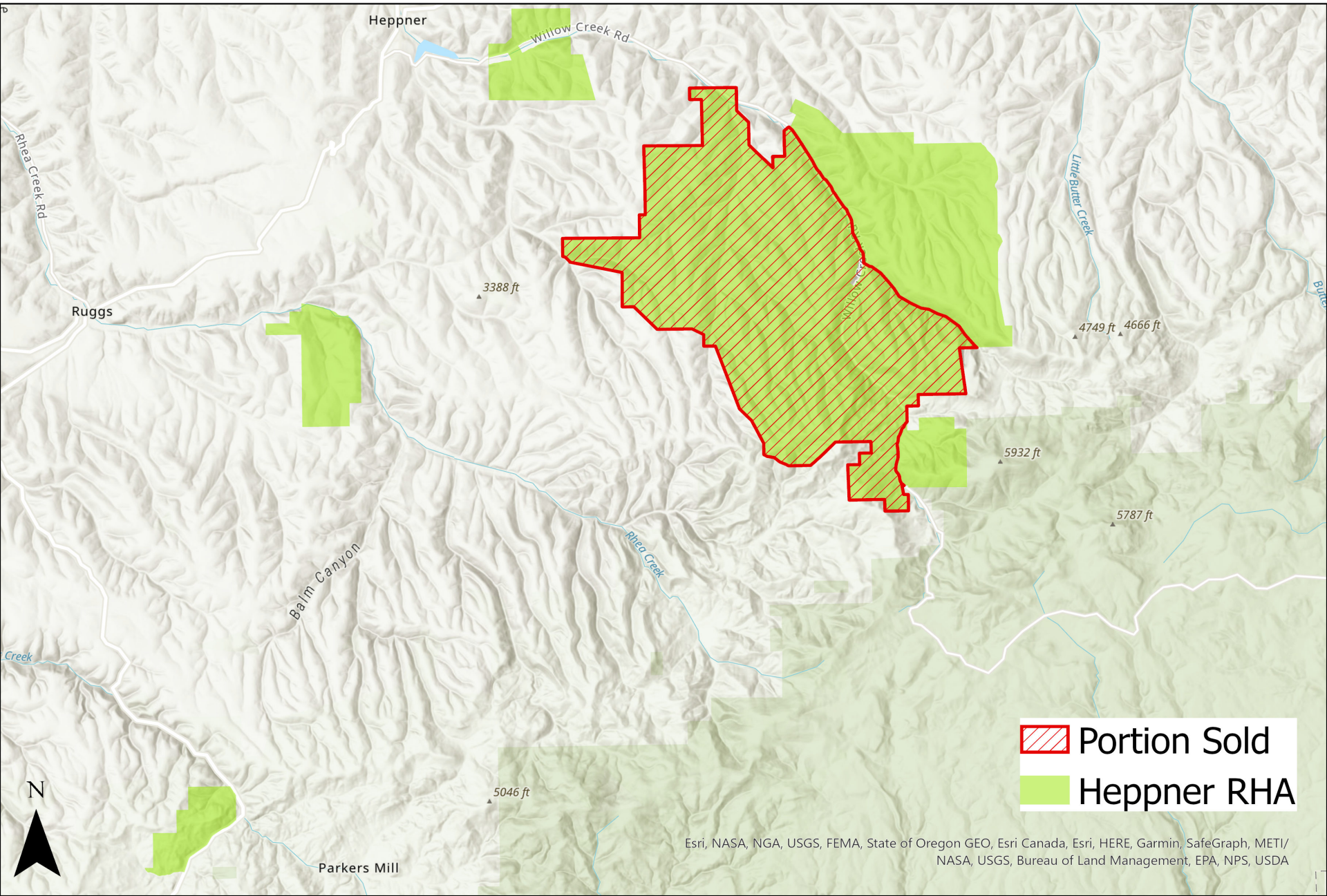
- 2,044 Acres

- Sage Grouse habitat and Critical Winter Range for Mule Deer
- Cooperators include OWEB and Lake Cty. Watershed Council and impacted landowners




- **Removes one Range, 25 east**
