2 **Damages for Commercial Fishing Violations**

3 (1) For purposes of ORS 506.720 the following shall be the 2021[2020] average market value for
 4 each species of food fish for 2022[2021]. For species not listed, the average market value shall
 5 be the price per pound paid to law enforcement officials for any fish or shellfish confiscated from
 6 the person being assessed damages, or the average price per pound paid for that species during
 7 the month in which the violation occurred, whichever is greater. Unless otherwise noted, the
 8 amount given is the price per pound and is based on round weight.
