Title: Angler Education Event Support Specialist

Description of Duties & Activities:

As an Event Support Specialist, you will help with event support and logistics.

Event Support:

- Manage registration/check-in process.
- Greet & direct participants, and other volunteers as necessary.
- Help set up/tear down materials and equipment.

Other:

- Report your volunteer hours.

Physical Demands:

Walking, sitting, reaching, repetitive motion, kneeling, reaching out, bending, carrying. Inside/outside, all types of weather conditions, uneven ground.

Equipment to be used:

Fishing Rod and Reel, line, hooks, bait, lures and bobbers

Restrictions:

Volunteer Event Support Specialist may not conduct driving duties, lead or instruct any portion of class, have one-on-one interactions with persons under 18 years of age, use, carry or transport firearms or munitions during their service with ODFW.
