**12:00 PM** - Welcome and Kick-Off Lunch. Arrive in Newport, OR. Meet at [Beverly Beach State Park Day Use area](#) for lunch provided by ODFW. Little Lois brown bag lunch – MUST be preordered by 5/01.

**1:20 PM** – Arrive at Oregon Coast Aquarium for a behind-the-scenes tour. [2820 SE Ferry Slip Rd, Newport, OR 97365](#)

Meet at front entrance of aquarium, we will all go in together as a group. Tour starts at 1:30pm.

**3:20 PM** – Leave cars at aquarium and walk to ODFW's South Beach Annex, [3248 SE Ferry Slip Rd, South Beach, OR 97366](#). From the main entrance walkway at the aquarium, it's 0.4 mile south (8 min walk) along Ferry Slip Rd, or closer if aquarium staff let us out the south staff entrance.

Tour of Marine Remotely Operated Vehicle (ROV) equipment with Scott Marion, ODFW Staff, who will be showing two small BlueROVs and a large Phantom ROV, along with displays of sampling equipment, and videos of ROV deployment/recovery and seafloor video footage.

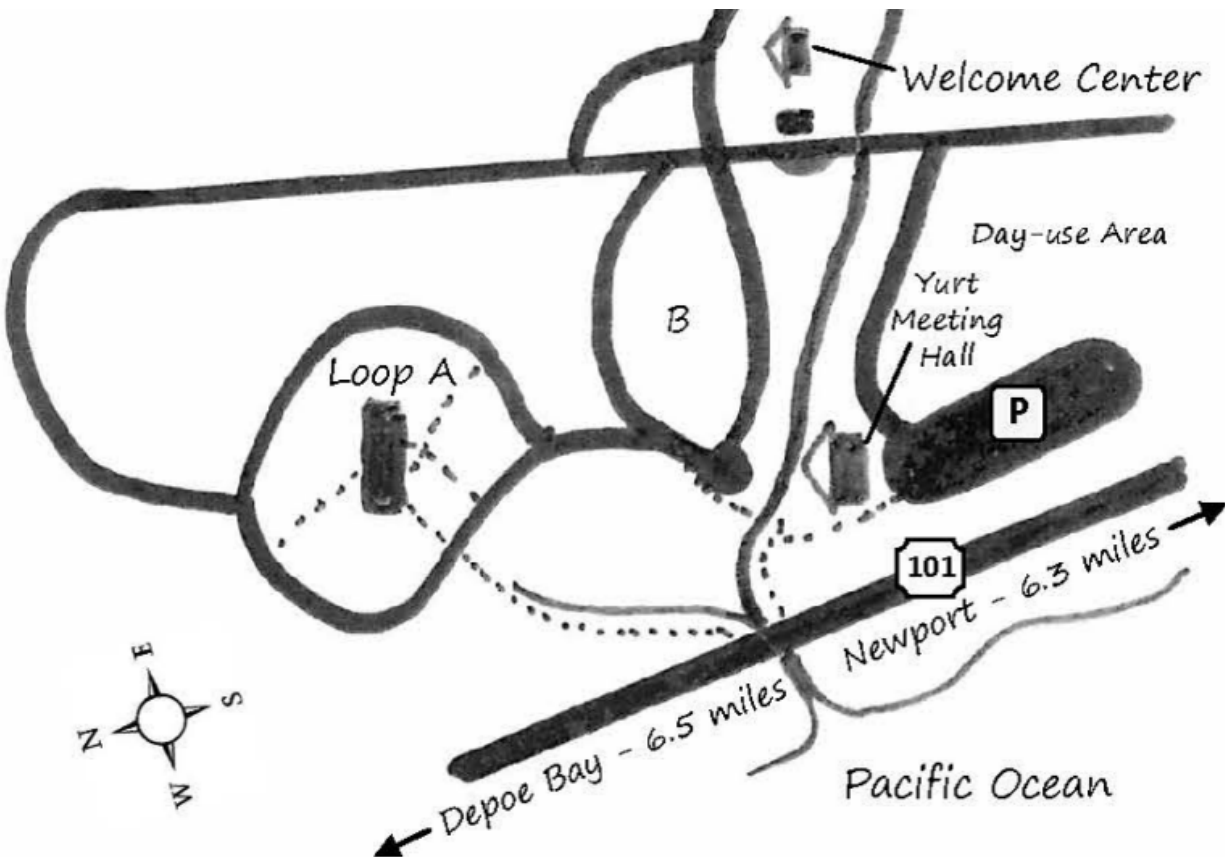
