 - Specific # of proposals
 - Based on what set of criteria
 - Etc.



Overall Observations

- Scores ranged from 24 – 57 out of 60
- Distributed as follows:
 - Top 1/3 – 49.5 – 57 (approximately)
 - Middle 1/3 - 42.5 – 49 (approximately)
 - Bottom 1/3 – 24 – 42 (approximately)



Things to note...

Top 19 had scores of ≥ 50

- 11 were on somebody's Top 3 list (2 were on two reviewer's Top 3 list)
- 6 proposals were on a Top 3 list but didn't make it to the top 19
- 5 proposals NOT in the Top 19 had significant reviewer variation in criteria B (most heavily weighted of our 6 criteria) – more on this later

NOTE: The next 4 projects below the Top 19 all have a base score of 49.5 - next slide reflects adding these 4 projects (Top 23)

- Added proposals 10, 17, 31 and 37 which all had >50, but weren't in the individual top 4 lists.
- Added proposal 60 and 7 (per request from Mark and Karl during meeting)

Next Steps: All members will score this group of proposals using original criteria and return to Davia/Cheralynn by Dec 4th.

Outdoor Equity Proposals

- Outdoor Equity sub-group is going to review the Top 13 proposals (>5.5 in Criteria F and/or in a reviewer's Top 4)
- Each member of the subcommittee will review the proposals with the following in mind:
 - Impact – tangibility of the outcomes and scope/scale of the impact
 - Trusted messengers – track record of being connected to communities of interest
 - Outreach - # of people to be engaged and/or involved in the effort
 - Financial viability of the proposal (details on how the funds w/b used)
- The subcommittee will meet and discuss how best to score/rank these proposals (Nov 25th)
- Subcommittee will come back to the AC with their recommendation for which proposals to fund using the set-aside funds
 - Due to Davia/Cheralynn by Dec 4th for incorporation into the meeting materials
