About this program . . .

The Oregon Hunter Education Program is funded through 1970 and 1972 amendments to the Federal Aid in Wildlife Restoration Act of 1937, better known as the Pittman-Robertson Act. Funds are derived from an excise tax on bows and arrows and handguns. The funds are distributed to state wildlife agencies by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Division of Federal Aid, based on the State's population. Seventy-five percent of the Oregon Hunter Education Program is financed from this source.
