The states of Oregon and Washington met today to review ongoing commercial fisheries and took the following actions:

Non-Indian Commercial Fisheries

Summer Chinook Commercial Fishery

- Adopted non-Indian commercial fishing periods as follows:

Season:	7 PM Thursday July 6 to 7 AM Friday July 7	(12 hours)
	7 PM Monday July 10 to 7 AM Tuesday July 11	(12 hours)
	7 PM Wednesday July 12 to 7 AM Thursday July 13	(12 hours)
	7 PM Monday July 17 to 7 AM Tuesday July 18	(12 hours)
	7 PM Wednesday July 19 to 7 AM Thursday July 20	(12 hours)
	7 PM Monday July 24 to 7 AM Tuesday July 25	(12 hours)
	7 PM Wednesday July 26 to 7 AM Thursday July 27	(12 hours)

Area: Zones 1-5.

Sanctuaries: Grays River, Elokomina-A, Cowlitz River, Kalama-A, Lewis-A, Washougal and Sandy River sanctuaries will be in effect.

Gear: 8" minimum and 9¾" maximum mesh size restrictions in effect.

Allowable Sales: Chinook, coho, shad, and white sturgeon.

All sockeye and steelhead must be released immediately.

A maximum of three white sturgeon in the aggregate may be possessed or sold by each participating vessel during each calendar week (Sunday through Saturday) the fishery is open. Green sturgeon may not be retained.

Future Meetings

- A Joint State hearing is scheduled for 2:00 PM Thursday July 6, 2006 via teleconference to review the ongoing summer Chinook sport fishery below Bonneville Dam. A Compact hearing will follow to discuss additional treaty Indian fisheries.
- A Columbia River Compact hearing is scheduled for 10:00 AM Thursday July 27, 2006 at the River Street Building located at 25 River Street in Cathlamet, Washington to review stock status of fall Chinook and consider non-Indian commercial fisheries.
