# Columbia River Action Notice

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today via phone to consider non-Indian commercial fishing options and took the following actions:

#### Non-Indian Fisheries

##### *Spring Chinook Commercial Salmon Fishery*

- No action was taken on this fishery. The fishery remains closed at this time.

#### Select Area Commercial Fisheries

- The following fishery modifications were adopted by Compact action in concurrent OR/WA jurisdiction waters and by the state of Oregon in state waters.

##### *Blind Slough Winter Salmon Fishery (Zone 74)*

- Open waters in Blind Slough up to the railroad bridge are under concurrent Oregon and Washington jurisdiction and open waters of Blind Slough above the railroad bridge are under Oregon state jurisdiction.
- Adopted additional winter commercial salmon fishing periods as follows:

##### Winter Fishery – Blind Slough Only

**Season:** 7 PM Sunday April 2 to 7 AM Monday April 3 (12 hours)  
7 PM Wednesday April 5 to 7 AM Thursday April 6 (12 hours)

**Open Area:** Open waters extend from markers at the mouth of Blind Slough  
**Blind Slough:** upstream to markers at the mouth of Gnat Creek which is located approximately ½ mile upstream of the county road bridge.

**Gear:** 7-inch minimum mesh size restriction is in effect.  
Nets restricted to maximum length of 100 fathoms with no weight restriction on leadline. Use of additional weights or anchors attached directly to the leadline is allowed.

**Allowable Sales:** Salmon, sturgeon, and shad.  
A maximum of three green or white sturgeon in the aggregate may be possessed or sold by each participating vessel during each calendar week (Sunday through Saturday) of the open fishing periods. The three sturgeon possession and sales limit includes all Select Area fisheries.

**Miscellaneous Regulations:** Special transportation permits are not required to take fish outside the fishing area. Permanent transportation rules are in effect.

**Washington Reporting Rule** WDFW adopted a regulation requiring all Washington wholesale buyers purchasing fish from the Select Area commercial fisheries to send a report of their landings to WDFW by 10 AM on the day after the purchase date via either:

**The state of Oregon took the following action:**

### **Non-Indian Commercial Fisheries**

#### ***Youngs Bay Select Area (Zone 7) Commercial Salmon Fisheries***

- Open waters in Youngs Bay are under Oregon State jurisdiction.
- Modified the following fishing periods as follows. Modifications in **bold**.

**Winter Season:** 6 AM to **8** PM Thursday March 30 (14 hours)  
6 AM to **8** PM Monday April 3 (14 hours)  
6 AM to **8** PM Thursday April 6 (14 hours)  
6 AM to **8** PM Monday April 10 (14 hours)  
6 AM to **8** PM Thursday April 13 (14 hours)

**Area:** Open waters extend from the markers directly under the first powerlines downstream of the Walluski River to the confluence of the Youngs and Klaskanine rivers.

### **FUTURE MEETINGS**

- There are no additional Compact hearings scheduled at this time. Compacts will occur as needed to modify ongoing fisheries.
