# Columbia River Fishery Notice

## Compact Action

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today via phone to review ongoing treaty Indian platform and hook-and-line fisheries in the mainstem Columbia River and took the following actions:

### Treaty Fisheries

- Closed the main-stem Zone 6 platform and hook-and-line fishery to commercial sales of all species effective 6 PM Sunday October 15, 2006. The platform and hook and line fishery will remain open for subsistence use under all other existing rules.
- Allow commercial sales and/or subsistence use during open fishing periods in the Zone 6 tributary fisheries in the Klickitat, Big White Salmon, and Drano Lake fisheries. Yakama fishers transporting fish for sale outside the immediate fishing area are required to possess a Yakama issued fish transport permit.

### **Future Compact Hearings**

- A Compact hearing has been scheduled for 10:00 AM Wednesday October 18, 2006 at the WDFW office located at 2108 Grand Boulevard, Vancouver, Washington to review salmon stock status and non-Indian commercial fisheries. A teleconference line will also be available.
