# Columbia River Fishery Notice

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today to review the non-Indian commercial Knappa Slough Select Area fishery and took the following action:

### Non-Indian Fisheries

#### *Select Area Commercial Fisheries*

The following fishery was **rescinded** by Compact action in concurrent OR/WA jurisdiction waters:

#### *Blind Slough/Knappa Slough Fishery (Zone 74)*

- **Rescinded** the previously adopted commercial fishing period in **Knappa Slough** as follows:

Season: Open 7 PM to 7 AM (12 hours) nightly during the following week:

Tuesday September 12 - Friday September 15 (3 nights)

- **Blind Slough** will remain open as scheduled.

The states of Oregon and Washington conferred today regarding ongoing mainstem Columbia River sport fisheries:

### Buoy 10 and Lower Columbia Sport Salmon Fisheries

- No action taken.

#### **Future Compact Hearings**

- A Joint State hearing has also been scheduled for 1:00 PM Wednesday, September 13, 2006 via teleconference to update salmon stock status and review recreational fisheries in the lower Columbia River.
- A Columbia River Compact hearing is also scheduled for 9:30 AM Thursday September 14, 2006 at Kalama City Hall in the Council Chambers located at 320 North 1<sup>st</sup> Street, Kalama, Washington to consider additional treaty Indian and late fall non-Indian commercial fisheries.

City Hall is in the middle of town, across from the Chevron Station. Council chambers entrance is to the right as you enter City Hall. **NB I-5 exit 30** - Turn right on Elm, Turn left onto N 1<sup>st</sup> Street.

**SB I-5 exit 30** - Turn left onto Oak Street, Turn right onto Frontage Road, Turn left onto Ivy Street, Turn right onto N 1st Street.
