The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today and took the following actions:

Non-Indian Fisheries

Commercial Mainstem Salmon Fisheries

- Adopted non-Indian commercial salmon seasons as follows:

Season:	7 AM Monday October 2 to 7 AM Tuesday October 3 (24 hrs)
Area:	Zones 1-5.
Sanctuaries:	Elokomin-B, Abernathy, Cowlitz, Kalama-B, Lewis-B, Sandy, and Washougal rivers sanctuaries are in effect.
Gear:	No minimum mesh size restriction in effect in Zones 1-3. 8 inch minimum mesh size restriction in effect in Zones 4-5.
Allowable Sales:	Salmon and white sturgeon. A maximum of eight white sturgeon in the aggregate may be possessed or sold by each participating vessel during each calendar week (Sunday through Saturday) of the open fishing periods. The eight white sturgeon possession and sales limit includes both mainstem and Select Area fisheries. Retention of green sturgeon is prohibited.
Washington Reporting Rule:	WDFW adopted a regulation requiring all Washington wholesale buyers purchasing fish from the commercial mainstem salmon fishery to send a report of their landings to WDFW by 10:00 AM on the day after the purchase date via either: a) FAX transmission to (360) 906-6776 or (360) 906-6777 b) E-mail to crfishtickets@dfw.wa.gov c) Telephone to 1-866-791-1281

- A Columbia River Compact hearing is also scheduled for 1:00 PM Wednesday October 4, 2006 via teleconference to consider additional non-Indian commercial fishing seasons in the mainstem Columbia River.
