# Columbia River Fishery Notice

## Joint State Action

March 19, 2008

The states of Oregon and Washington met today via telephone to consider modifications to the recreational sturgeon fisheries in the Columbia River and took the following actions:

### *Mainstem Columbia River Recreational Fisheries*

#### **John Day Pool (John Day Dam to McNary Dam)**

- Effective 12:01 AM Wednesday March 26, 2008 the retention of sturgeon in the Columbia River and tributaries between John Day and McNary Day dams will be prohibited.
- All other permanent angling regulations described in the "2008 Oregon Sport Fishing Regulations Pamphlet" remain in effect.

#### **FUTURE MEETINGS**

- No additional Compact or Joint State hearings are scheduled at this time.
