The state of Oregon took the following actions:

### Non-Indian Fisheries

#### *Youngs Bay Select Area (Zone 7) Commercial Salmon Fisheries*

- Open waters in Youngs Bay are under Oregon State jurisdiction.
- Adopted the following area modification for three previously adopted winter fishing periods as follows. Modification in **bold**.

#### Upstream of old Youngs Bay Bridge

Noon Sunday March 30 to 6 AM Monday March 31	(18 hours)	<b>Old Youngs Bay Bridge upstream to the confluence of the Youngs and Klaskanine rivers.</b>
6 AM to 6 PM Tuesday April 1	(12 hours)	
6 AM to 6 PM Thursday April 3	(12 hours)
