Revised Joint State Action

In joint Oregon and Washington state action after the Compact adjourned; the states discussed the following mainstem Columbia sport fisheries and took the following actions:

Non-Indian Sport Fisheries

Columbia River Mainstem Steelhead and Shad Recreational Fishery

- The opening of the mainstem Columbia River steelhead and jack Chinook recreational fishery from Tongue Point upstream to the I-5 Bridge, scheduled to open on May 16 under permanent rules, will be delayed until further notice, but will open no later than June 16, 2008.
- The mainstem Columbia River shad recreational fishery downstream of Bonneville Dam will open on May 16, 2008 under permanent rules.

FUTURE MEETINGS

- A hearing has been set for 1 PM Monday May 19, 2008 via teleconference to review stock status information and non-Indian fisheries.
