The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today via phone and took the following actions:

#### **Non-Indian Fisheries**

##### ***Select Area Commercial Fisheries***

**No action taken.**

**Fisheries will re-open May 19, 2008 with previously adopted rules including:**

- Tongue Point/South Channel Fishery – For each fishing period, participating fishers are required to call 503-325-3418 and leave a message including name, catch, and where and when the fish will be sold.
- Youngs Bay Fishery - Season re-opens at 7 PM Monday May 19, 2008.

#### **FUTURE MEETINGS**

- No Compact/Joint State hearings have been scheduled at this time. The Joint Staff will continue to monitor progress of the spring Chinook run and provide updates and schedule hearings as needed.
