Compact Action

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today via phone and took the following actions in concurrent OR/WA jurisdiction waters and by the state of Oregon or Washington in state waters:

Non-Indian Fisheries

Select Area Commercial Fisheries

- Effective noon Wednesday June 4 through Friday June 13, 2008 the retention of white sturgeon is prohibited in the Blind Slough/Knappa Slough, Tongue Point/South Channel, and Deep River Select Area spring commercial fisheries.

Oregon State Action

The state of Oregon took the following actions:

Youngs Bay Commercial Salmon Fishery (Zone 7)

- Effective noon Wednesday June 4 through Thursday July 31, 2008 the retention of white sturgeon is prohibited in the Youngs Bay Select Area spring and summer commercial fisheries.

FUTURE MEETINGS

- No Compact/Joint State hearings have been scheduled at this time. The Joint Staff anticipates a hearing will be scheduled within the next two weeks to discuss non-Indian and treaty Indian summer Chinook commercial fisheries.
