Compact Action

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today and took the following actions:

Treaty Fisheries

- Closed the main-stem Zone 6 platform and hook-and-line fishery to commercial sales of all species effective 6 PM Wednesday November 12, 2008. The platform and hook and line fishery will remain open for subsistence use under all other existing regulations.
- Allow commercial sales of Chinook and coho only in the Zone 6 tributary fisheries in the Klickitat and Big White Salmon Rivers. Chinook and coho sold outside a one-mile radius from the Klickitat Falls may be sold by a Yakama Nation Transfer Permit only.

- No Compact or Joint State hearings have been scheduled at this time.
